THE GAME • It is Western Michigan's 84th Homecoming game and the opponent is a high-powered offensive team in Ball State. The Broncos come into this game in control of its own destiny in the Mid-American Conference West Division but are looking for their first home win over the Cardinals since 2003.

TELEVISION • The Bronco football program continues to gain regional and national notoriety through television exposure. Western Michigan is scheduled to play on live television at least six times this season. WMU will air on the ESPN family networks twice at home in 2007. The Broncos will have two games on Comcast Local and another on Comcast SportsNet. The Ball State game will be the first of those games on Comcast Local.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play) and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past nine seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page.

SERIES IN BRIEF • Western Michigan leads the all-time series 19-14-0 with a 12-5-0 advantage at Waldo Stadium. Over the past two seasons, the home team has not been able to hold serve as WMU went to Muncie, Ind., last season and came away with a win and BSU defeated the Broncos at Waldo in dramatic fashion in 2005. WMU is also looking for consecutive wins over Ball State for the first time since 1999 and 2000.

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his third season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 16-12 overall (.571), 10-2 at Waldo Stadium (.833), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 last season. Brady Hoke (Ball State, 1982) is in his fifth season as the head coach of the Cardinals football program. He is 4-3 this season and 19-34 during his time with the Cardinals.

UP NEXT • Western Michigan will play on the road at MAC West rival Eastern Michigan on Oct. 27 at 3:30 p.m. That game will be televised on Comcast Local. The Broncos have won two straight over the Eagles and 13 of the last 15. This will be first time since 2003 that WMU will play EMU at Rynearson Stadium as the two teams took played one another at Ford Field in 2005.

GAME 8 — WESTERN MICHIGAN VS. BALL STATE — GAME NOTES

SHUTTING THINGS DOWN • The Western Michigan defense came alive in the third quarter against Northern Illinois. It forced and recovered a fumble on the third play to set up the offense's go-ahead score. It also held NIU to eight offensive plays and 12 yards.

TAKE YOUR TIME • WMU's offense also contributed to the Huskies' lack of offensive output in the third quarter. The Bronco offense was on the field for 11:02 of the quarter, leaving NIU just 3:58 of offense. Western Michigan is controlling the ball well this season, having the ball on offense 4:24 more than the opposition.

PITCHING THE SHUT OUT • The Bronco defense held an opponent scoreless in the second half for the first time this season. It is the first time WMU has not allowed a single point in any half since shutting out Akron in the 2006 season finale (17-0).

AHEAD OF THE GAME • In 2006 Jamarko Simmons had 61 receptions for 668 yards and two touchdowns. In 2007 he has 60 catches for 696 yards and six TDs. The difference is the fact that Simmons still has at least five more game remaining in this season and he is already past his offensive output from his sophomore year. As things sit now, he is on pace to catch 120 passes for 1,392 yards and 12 touchdowns. The receptions and yards would be single-season records.

WHAT IS ON THE HORIZON • Since moving to receiver full time at the beginning of the 2006 season Jamarko Simmons has put up solid numbers and is on the cusp of entering the list of elite at Western Michigan.

NATIONAL SCENE • Simmons has had one of the top-10 receiving performances in the country on two separate occasions this season. His 158 yards against Indiana was the sixth-best receiving performance in the country for week two and his 172-yard output against Akron ranked fourth in all of Division I (FBS) for week six.

PRIDE OF SOUTHGATE • Dustin Duclou led the Bronco defense with 10 tackles against Northern Illinois. It was the second double-digit tackle effort of the season for the Southgate, Mich., native. More importantly, Duclou recovered a pair of fumbles in a game for the first time since the Florida State game on Nov. 18, 2006. Duclou's first fumble recovery came on the third play of the third quarter. The recovery gave the ball to WMU and led to the go-ahead score. His second recovery was on the final play of the game, securing the win.

THE ART OF THE POOCH • Western Michigan's Mike Jones made 1-of-2 field goals against Northern Illinois but his two pooch punts in the second half were key to WMU's road win. Jones' first-career punt traveled just 21 yards but pinned NIU at its own eight-yard line. His second, a career-long 30 yards, pinned the Huskies at their own three-yard line.

PULLING THE DOUBLE • For the second time this season Western Michigan has had multiple Broncos earn MAC West Player of the Week honors. This week Dustin Duclou was named MAC West Co-Defensive Player of the Week (the second of his career and first since 2005) and Mike Jones earned his first ever weekly conference award as he was named the MAC West Special Teams Player of the Week. Altogether, WMU has earned eight weekly conference awards so far this season and have had at least one honoree in each week except weeks three and four.

ROAD TESTED • Western Michigan has won its first two MAC West games on the road for the first time since divisional play was instituted in 1997. WMU's first road win over Toledo was the first at the Glass Bowl since 1988. This past week's win at Huskie Stadium was the first since 1999.

MAMA I'M COMIN' HOME • Every week should be Homecoming week for Western Michigan football. During the Cubit era WMU has played in (either home or away) six homecoming games and the Broncos boast a 5-1 record in those games. WMU played in four homecoming games in 2006, winning all but the one at Florida State, a 28-20 loss. The Broncos handed Virginia and Ball State homecoming losses in 2006 and did the same to Northern Illinois on Oct. 13.

ROUGH START/KICK START • The first offensive drive of the game for Western Michigan has not been productive so far this season. Through seven games the Broncos have committed a turnover on its first possession of the game and punted five other times.

Conversely, WMU has had much success with the first possession of the second half, scoring a touchdown in each of the last four games on its first offensive possession of the second half.

BREAKING UP IS HARD TO DO • The Western Michigan secondary has 32 pass break ups through seven games this season. A big part of that is Londen Fryar. The junior cornerback has a league-best 12 pass deflections and 13 passes defensed. His 1.86 passes defensed per game ranks third in the nation behind Trey Brown of UCLA (2.17) and Oregon's Walter Thurmond III (2.00).

Fryar had a school-record six deflections against Akron and a huge deflection late in the fourth quarter against NIU on third down with the Huskies attempting to move into WMU territory. The deflection brought up fourth down and eventually ended Northern Illinois' threat.

In his career, Fryar has 17 passes defensed, six interceptions and two defensive TDs. On of those TDs was an interception return (Toledo, 2006), the other was a return off a blocked kick (Temple, 2006).

KEEPING THE STREAK ALIVE • With a pair of fumble recoveries against Northern Illinois, Western Michigan extended its consecutive games with a take away streak to 33-straight games.

MID-SEASON REPORT • Phil Steele's College Football Preview is seen across the nation as the premier preseason publication in college football. For the first time, Phil Steele has announced his Mid-Season All-America and All-Conference Teams. Western Michigan had seven Broncos garner all-conference nods and one earn his way onto the all-America team.

Krutilla is on the Rimington Trophy Watch List (the award for the nation's best center) as well as the Outland Trophy (the award for the nation's best interior lineman). It is the second year he has made it onto the Rimington preseason list.

Ledbetter finds himself on the John Mackey Award Watch List (the award for the nation's best tight end) for the first time. He was named the Mackey Tight End of the Week once last season after amassing 101 yards receiving against Miami.

WMU went a combined 42-18-1 over that span. Ranking second is a span of four seasons (1997-2000) when the Broncos won 31-15, won nine games (2000) for only the second time in program history and appeared in a two-straight MAC title games.

Another eight-win campaign would put this team in a class by itself for being the only one to capture back-to-back seasons with eight wins or better.

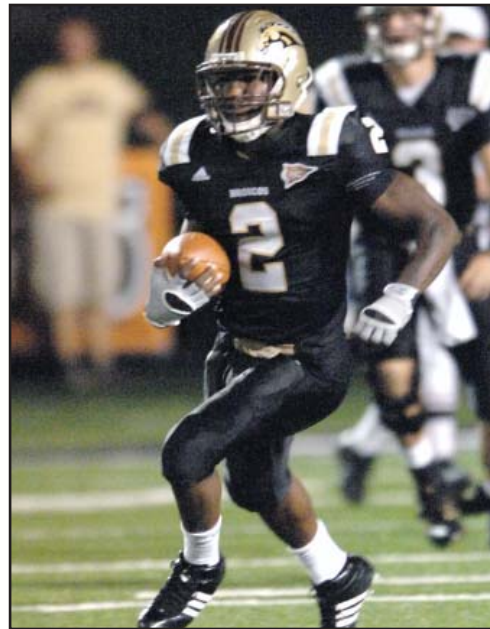
