THE GAME • Billed as the "Tuesday Night Tussle," the 78th meeting between Western Michigan and Central Michigan will air live on national television on ESPN2. The Broncos are looking to avoid their first losing season since 2004, while the Chippewas are looking to keep hopes alive for a MAC West Division title. Both teams are also in the hunt for the Michigan MAC Championship.

TELEVISION • The Bronco football program continues to gain regional and national notoriety through television exposure. Western Michigan is scheduled to play on live television at least six times this season. WMU will air on the ESPN family networks twice at home in 2007. Tuesday night's match up will be the first nationally televised game from Waldo Stadium, airing live on ESPN2. Rob Wischusen (play-by-play) and Ray Bentley (analyst) will have the call of the game from the booth and Todd Harris will roam the sidelines.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play) and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past nine seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for

SERIES IN BRIEF • The WMU vs. CMU rivalry dates back to 1907 when the Broncos claimed a series-opening 27-0 victory at home. WMU boasts a 43-32-2 edge in the all-time series with the Chippewas and have won four of the last six meetings. There have been 19 shut outs in favor of the Broncos with 13 of those coming in front of a home crowd. The two teams have tied twice but only one of those times resulted in no points for either team (1925).

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his third season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 16-12 overall (.571), 10-2 at Waldo Stadium (.833), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 last season. Butch Jones (Ferris State, 1990) takes over as the CMU head coach in 2007 after spending two seasons with West Virginia. Jones had previously been on the Central Michigan staff from 1998-2004.

UP NEXT • Western Michigan has its final non-conference test of the season when the Broncos travel to Iowa City to take on the Hawkeyes in a MAC-Big Ten showdown. WMU holds a 1-0-0 lead in the all-time series, taking a win from Iowa, 27-21, en route to a 9-3 record in 2000.

AT THE HART OF THE MATTER • Defenses may look to kick away from Brandon West on kick offs because of his 26.9 yards per return average but he is not the only threat emerging on WMU's special teams. Senior Anthony Gebhart hauled in two kick offs against Eastern Michigan, returning a pair of kicks for a career-best 51 yards. That included a career-long kick return of 32 yards.

WELCOME BACK • Tight end Matt Stevens made his second start of the season against Eastern Michigan after missing almost all of spring, all of pre-season camp and the first seven games of 2007 with a knee injury. Stevens registered his first catch of the year from seven yards out against the Eagles.

SAFETY DANCE • Boston McCormell registered WMU's first safety since Louis Delmas did so on Oct. 29, 2005 against Kent State. McCormell's scoring stop came with 25 seconds remaining in the opening quarter against Eastern Michigan. That coupled with his interception for a score against Central Connecticut State earlier this season gives the linebacker eight points on the year.

LOUIS VIII • Junior free safety hauled in his first interception of 2007 after kicking off his Bronco career with four picks in 2005 and three more in 2006. Delmas' eight interceptions are best among active Bronco defenders

OH WHAT A NIGHT • The Monday Night Football broadcast on Oct. 29 may have been a first as a receiver from one team, a tight end from the other and the referee all had ties to Western Michigan. Greg Jennings (Green Bay) finished the night with six receptions for 141 yards and a game-winning TD in overtime. Tony Scheffler (Denver), former teammate of Jennings at WMU, hauled in three catches for 28 yards and his fifth-career TD.

Keeping a watchful eye over the proceedings was Ron Winter, in his 13th year as an NFL official (10th as a referee), Winter is also a professor at WMU's in Health, Physical Education & Recreation. The game was later dubbed WMU Bowl I by WMU Director of Football Operations Tim Knox.

Ironically, it was Scheffler and Jennings that started and finished the scoring on the night and Jennings' 82-yard catch and run to improve the Packers to 6-1 was the second-longest scoring play in overtime in NFL history. Ron Jaworski to Mike Quick for 99 yards holds the record.

BREAKING DOWN THE PASS • Western Michigan signal callers have had a multitude of options to throw to this season and they have taken advantage. Seven wide receivers have caught a pass in 2007, followed by four tight ends and three running backs. Of the 17 TD passes, 10 have gone to a wide receiver (58.8 percent), six to a tight end (35.3 percent) and 1 to a running back (5.9 percent). WMU quarterbacks have completed 211 passes in 2007 and a wide receiver has been the one with the catch almost two out of every three times. Receivers have caught 132 balls (62.6 percent), tight ends have caught 42 passes (19.9 percent) and backs are not too far behind with 37 receptions (17.5 percent).

THE START OF SOMETHING NEW • WMU had its streak of 33 games with a take away (nation's best) snapped against Ball State but a new streak has begun with Louis Delmas' pick in the end zone at EMU. Last season the Broncos recorded one take away against CMU.

BRONCOS AT WALDO IN THIS SERIES • Western Michigan and Central Michigan have played one another in Waldo Stadium 31 times since first matching up in 1944 (WMU 35, CMU 14). During that span, the Broncos have captured 18 victories and has outscored the Chippewas, 714-607, at Waldo Stadium.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE • Since 1993, the home team has won every meeting between Western Michigan and Central Michigan except twice. The Broncos were the most recent to stage a coup on foreign soil, claiming a 35-10 win in Mount Pleasant in 2002. CMU grabbed a 23-18 victory in 1993.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR • Robbie Krutilla and Branden Ledbetter find their names among the nation's elite in their respective positions. Krutilla has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists and Ledbetter has earned a spot on one. Krutilla is on the Rimington Trophy Watch List (the award for the nation's best center) as well as the Outland Trophy (the award for the nation's best interior lineman). It is the second year he has made it onto the Rimington preseason list.

Ledbetter finds himself on the John Mackey Award Watch List (the award for the nation's best tight end) for the first time. He was named the Mackey Tight End of the Week once last season after amassing 101 yards receiving against Miami.

Jim Laney was added to the Ray Guy Watch List, the award for the nation's top punter, after the third week of the 2007 season. Anthony Gebhart was nominated for the National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete Award, which will

CAPTAIN O' CAPTAIN • It looks as if for the first time in program history, Western Michigan football would not have season captains. This season began with the Broncos choosing game captains for its first two games.

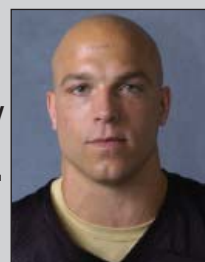

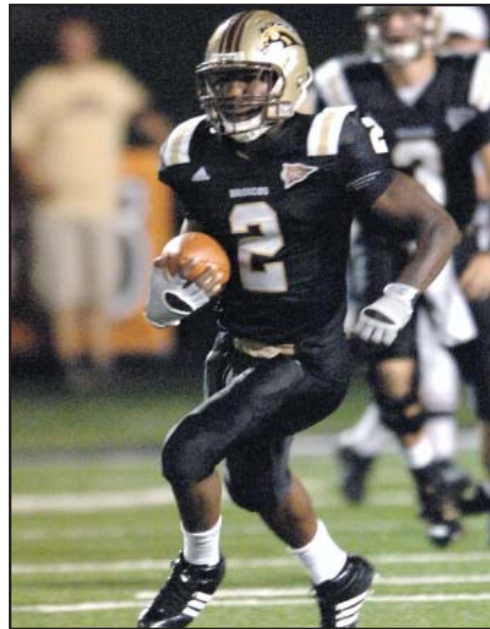
