**THE GAME** • Western Michigan enters the 2007 season finale looking for its second-straight win after defeating Iowa on the road, 28-19. The Broncos are looking for their third victory in as many seasons over the visiting Temple Owls. Temple is also coming off a win and looks to finish its first season in the Mid-American Conference with five league wins. WMU and Temple enter the contest with identical 4-7 overall records and a win for either team gives them momentum heading into the off-season.

**TELEVISION** • The Bronco football program continues to gain regional and national notoriety through television exposure. Western Michigan is scheduled to play on live television at least six times this season. WMU will air on the ESPN family networks twice at home in 2007 and once on the Big Ten Network.

**RADIO** • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play) and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past nine seasons.

**WEB SITE** • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site ([www.wmubroncos.com](http://www.wmubroncos.com)) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page.

**SERIES IN BRIEF** • Western Michigan is 5-0-0 all-time against Temple in the series. The Owls defeated WMU, 49-17, in the series opener in 1986 but later had to forfeit the game due to the use of an ineligible participant. All but one of the Broncos' wins over the Owls have come at Waldo Stadium. The lone road victory was in head coach Bill Cubit's first season, 2005. It was a 19-16 win at Lincoln Financial Field.

**THE COACHES** • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his third season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 19-16 overall (.543), 10-5 at Waldo Stadium (.667), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 last season. Al Golden (Penn State, 1991) has turned the Temple football program around. In just his second season, he took a team that captured one win (over Bowling Green) in 2006 to a team on the verge of finishing with five wins overall and in the MAC. The Owls had a season-long three-game win streak earlier in the year, capturing victories vs. Northern Illinois, at Akron and against MAC East champion Miami.

**UP NEXT** • The Western Michigan football team will close its 102nd season with the annual team banquet at the Radisson Plaza Hotel in downtown Kalamazoo on Sunday, Dec. 9. The coaching staff will then continue the recruiting process and the public will find out the the Class of 2012 on National Signing Day, which is Wednesday, Feb. 6, 2008.

## GAME 12 – WESTERN MICHIGAN VS. TEMPLE – GAME NOTES

**TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE** • Western Michigan football had two of its members earn MAC West weekly awards for the third time this season.

Tim Hiller was named MAC West Offensive Player of the Week for the first time this season and second time in his career. Hiller threw for 367 yards and three TDs on 26-for-45 passing with no interceptions in the win against Iowa. It was his fourth 300-yard passing performance of the season but first outside of Waldo Stadium.

Brandon West was named the MAC West Special Teams Player of the Week for the third time this year. West racked up 291 all-purpose yards (116 rushing, 93 receiving, 82 kick returns) to break the WMU single-season all-purpose yard record. He now stands at 2,065 with a game remaining. West touched the ball 43 times in the Broncos' win at Iowa.

**BIG BAD BCS** • Western Michigan's win over Iowa marks the second time in as many seasons the Broncos have gone on the road and defeated a team from a BCS conference in its own stadium. WMU defeated Virginia on the road, during the Cavaliers' Homecoming in 2006. This win also marked the only win against a bowl eligible team from a conference with an automatic BCS bowl bid.

**SENIOR MOMENTS** • Prior to the season finale against Temple, Western Michigan football will say good-bye to 17 seniors that helped the program turn things around during their redshirt freshman season of 2004 to reaching a bowl game during their reshift junior season of 2006.

**B-MOVIE** • Brandon West's sophomore campaign is more like a highlight reel than a movie. The Brunswick, Ga., native registered 82 kick return yards against Iowa to break the Western Michigan single-season record for kick return yardage. He bested Rashad McDade's mark of 898 yards set in 1999. McDade also currently holds the conference record but three MAC student-athletes have already eclipsed the mark and now it is a matter of who will be the new record holder.

West has had four games this season with at least 230 all-purpose yards, including a school best 346 yards against Indiana. His 291 all-purpose yards against Iowa rank fourth all-time at Western Michigan.

**LIKE TOTALLY** • Western Michigan's offense posted 489 total yards against an Iowa team that had been allowing 338.6 yards per game heading into its season finale. The total offensive output matched the most given up by the Hawkeyes in 2007 (Michigan State) and the 367 passing yards allowed was 150.4 yards more than their average of 216.6 heading into the game.

**PLAYING WITH THE BIG BOYS** • Jamarko Simmons has amassed nearly 1,000 yards this season on the second-best single-season receptions total in school history. He has had some of this biggest games against the biggest competition. Simmons has amassed 490 yards receiving and half of his six receiving TDs against West Virginia, Indiana, Missouri and Iowa. He has hauled in 44 of his 83 receptions against those same four opponents and in those four games has averaged 11.36 yards per catch and 122.50 yards per game.

Simmons continues to climb the receiving yards and receptions ladder in the WMU record book. Listed below is where he currently stands in career receptions, single-season receiving yards and receptions.

**MR. 3000** • There has only been one player to eclipse the 3,000-yard passing mark at Western Michigan uniform and he did so twice. Tim Lester threw for 3,311 yards in 1998 and came back in 1999 to better that mark by over 300 yards, setting the record at 3,639.

Tim Hiller currently has 2,745 yards passing in 2007. He is averaging 249.5 yards passing per game. He has thrown 255 yards or more (the amount needed to join Lester) on four occasions in 2007 but he will be facing the conference's best pass efficiency defense, pass defense and total defense (not to mention the MAC's best rush defense and third-best scoring defense) in Temple.

**WELCOME TO THE PARTY, PAL** • E.J. Biggers and Desman Stephen joined seven other Bronco teammates with at least one interception this season when each recorded their first of the year against Iowa. The pick in the end zone gives Biggers four for his career and it was Stephen's second. His first also came on the road in a win against a BCS opponent (Virginia - 2006).

**I THINK I'M GOING TO BOSTON** • That is the opposite of what opposing offenses are thinking as junior linebacker Boston McCornell is now just seven tackles away from 100 on the season. He registered his third-straight game of 10 tackles or more with 10 against Iowa.

**THANK YOU FANS** • Western Michigan is having one of its best seasons in terms of fan attendance in 2007. Through five games, WMU is averaging 21,660 fans per home game. That is the most since the Broncos averaged 22,395 in five games in 2001. In order for WMU to finish the season with an average of 21,000 fans - 17,699 would need to attend this Saturday's game against Temple. In order for WMU to average 20,000 fans or more for the first time since 2001, there would need to be 11,699 at this Saturday's game.

**STUCK IN THE MIDDLE WITH YOU** • The string of successful tight ends at Western Michigan under the tutelage of Jake Moreland continues as Anthony Middleton broke out for a career day against Iowa. The Deerfield Beach, Fla., native hauled in four

catches for 60 yards and two TDs (all career highs) in the win over the Hawkeyes. Middleton's first TD grab came on fourth-and-one from a career-long 35 yards out. Prior to last Saturday, the true freshman had more than one catch in a game only once this season (against Central Michigan the week before).

**THE STUDENT BECOMES THE TEACHER** • Jake Moreland made his mark as a player under Bill Cubit en route to becoming WMU's most prolific tight end. Now he is passing that on to his corps of tight ends. During Moreland's reign as the position's coach 43.1 percent of the touchdowns thrown have gone to a tight end (31-of-72).

**WRIGHT PLACE, WRIGHT TIME** • Redshirt sophomore back up safety Jonathan Wright had played in 12 career games with six career tackles prior to the Iowa game. In the first quarter, after WMU scored an opening drive touchdown, Wright made his first-career fumble recovery, jumping on a fumble forced by Louis Delmas at Iowa's 30-yard line. The turnover turned into three points for WMU with 9:09 left in the first quarter.

**ON THE TOP OF THE WORLD** • Temple has turned itself around in its first full season in the MAC. Heading into the final week of the season, the Owls lead the conference in four statistical categories. Temple ranks first in rushing defense (164.91 ypg), pass efficiency defense (121.51), total defense (356.64 ypg) and pass defense (191.73 ypg). The Owls also rank third in scoring defense (27.18 ppg).

**FINISH THEM** • Western Michigan has had an abundance of success in home finales during the history of Waldo Stadium. The Broncos are 44-24 (.647) in the final home game of a season at Waldo Stadium and are a perfect 2-0 under Bill Cubit.

When the final home game also happens to be the final game of the regular season, the Brown & Gold are 26-11 (.703) since 1939.

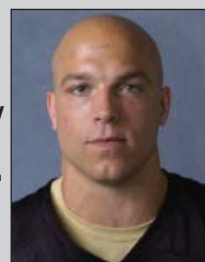

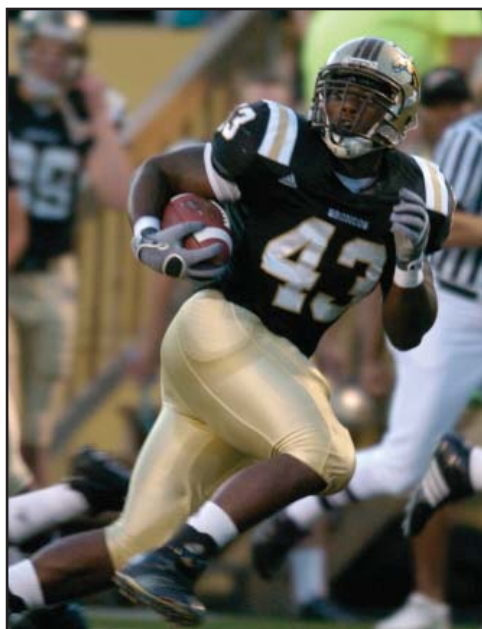
