REPRESENTATIVE TONG ENDORSES BARACK OBAMA, FORMER STUDENT TO SUPPORT SENATOR FOR PRESIDENT

Democratic State Rep. William Tong (D-Stamford, New Canaan) formally endorsed Senator Barack Obama (D-IL) today for President of the United States of America. A former student of Senator Obama at the University of Chicago Law School, Rep. Tong was inspired by Senator Obama to service and to become the first Asian American to be elected at the state level in Connecticut's history.
