Bond Facts

- Built at a cost savings to ECISD taxpayers
- Built schools with added features due to cost savings
- Built with the use of local contractors/subcontractors
- Built with a voter approved 7 cent bond tax increase of which 5 cents have been phased in and 2 cents are pending to be added within the next two years
- Built with the state picking up 51.5 percent of bond repayment

At **1.2398** the **2010 ECISD tax rate** is one of the lowest among Valley school districts.

In May 2008, Edinburg voters overwhelmingly approved a \$111,920,000 school bond issue to build new schools, make additions and renovations.

The Edinburg CISD Board of Trustees, district administration, and the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee are proud to report that the bond construction projects are on time and within budget as promised.

Three of the four new elementary school are already serving students. The fourth new elementary school is very near completion and construction is rapidly progressing on the two new middle schools. They should all be ready for occupancy in the fall of 2011. The existing Harwell Middle School will undergo renovations to convert it into the district's fourth high school. The Brewster school projects are near total completion.
