Spring and Summer (April – October): daily 10 am – 6 pm

**How to reach Hambach Castle:**

- **By public transportation:** From the main stations at Mannheim, Ludwigshafen and Kaiserslautern there is a regular train connection to Neustadt main station. From there, please take the bus line 502 and leave at the bus stop “Hambacher Schloss”.
- **By car:** You will have to leave the A 61 at the Mutterstadt crossing and change onto the A 65 (direction Landau). Please, leave the A 65 at Neustadt (Süd) an der Weinstraße and follow the signs to Hambach / Hambacher Schloss on the B 39.
