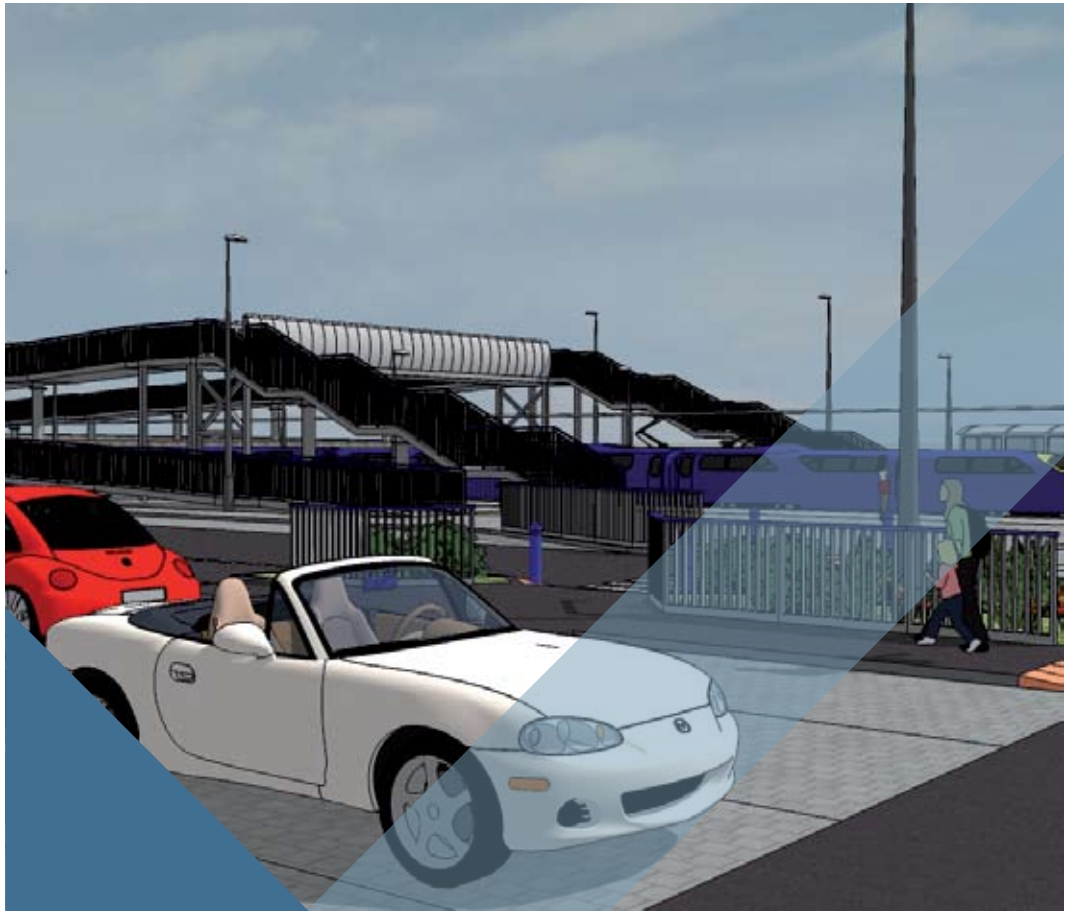

# Relocated Drumgelloch Station

## What facilities will my new station have?

- A fully accessible un-staffed station
- 2 new platforms
- Self service ticket machines for quick, convenient ticket purchase
- Safe, sheltered waiting areas with 24 hr CCTV
- Excellent Park & Ride facilities
- New and improved access links to key local roads and facilities
- 336 car-parking spaces
- 18 spaces for those with disabilities

## Where will the relocated Drumgelloch station be?

Drumgelloch station will be relocated 550 metres to the east of the existing station and will be accessible from Old Boar Road, Drumgelloch.

## How often will trains stop at my station?

Two trains an hour in each direction will stop at Drumgelloch.

c.44 minute journey to Edinburgh

c.28 minute journey to Glasgow

## When can I use the Airdrie-Bathgate Rail Link?

From 2010 you will be able to use the Airdrie-Bathgate Rail Link to commute to Edinburgh and Glasgow as well as other stations in between.

## Did you know?

Drumgelloch was formerly a village in its own right and part of New Monkland Parish, however, it became an eastern suburb of Airdrie as the town expanded.
