St. Barbara Symposium 2008 Technology Day at Schrobenhausen Test Range

More than 50 visitors of governments from 18 countries joined the St. Barbara Symposium on 04 December 2008 at Schrobenhausen Test Range.

The day was filled with live firing tests comprising demonstrations of IBD's AMAP protection technologies against ballistic threats of small and medium calibers, shaped charges and EFP-IEDs. Another test sequence demonstrated the active protection system AMAP-ADS.
