### **#1 David Montgomery • 5-7 • 165 • RB • Jr.-2L • Sugar Hill, Ga. / North Gwinnett HS**

Fast, agile back who led GWU in rushing as a sophomore with 736 yards and six touchdowns ... Also the team's third-leading receiver with 35 catches ... Will challenge for All-Big South honors in 2008 ... Has rushed for 1,085 career yards in two seasons.

### **#7 Dobson Collins • 6-2 • 175 • WR • Sr.-3L • Stone Mountain, Ga. / Stone Mountain HS**

All-Big South Conference selection at receiver and punt returner ... NFL prospect ... Ran the 40-yard dash in 4.47 seconds during spring testing ... Ran the 20-yard shuttle in a blazing fast 4.03 seconds ... Former Atlantic Sun Conference champion in the 60m hurdles ... Caught 51 passes for 649 yards and three touchdowns in 2007 ... Big play threat.

### **#8 Stan Doolittle • 6-3 • 215 • QB • Jr.-2L • Ninety Six, S.C. / Ninety Six HS**

All-Big South Conference candidate ... Enters junior season with more confidence and improved agility ... Ran the 40-yard dash in 4.8 seconds during spring testing ... Smart, tough quarterback with good arm strength ... Led team with 1,475 yards and nine touchdowns last season as a true sophomore ... Changed jersey numbers from #15 to #8 following spring drills.

### **#18 Nick Melton • 6-1 • 195 • WR • Jr.-3L • Roebuck, S.C. / Dorman HS**

Converted quarterback ... Smart, saavy receiver who has improved in all facets of his game since switching positions early in 2007 ... Good athlete with above average leaping ability and speed ... Great hands .. Caught 13 passes for 141 yards last season after moving into the starting lineup ... Also one of the Big South Conference's top holders on PATs and field goals.

### **#40 Patrick Hall • 5-11 • 205 • RB • So.-1L • Gastonia, N.C. / Ashbrook HS**

Potentially one of the brightest spots on the Gardner-Webb offense ... Has added considerable muscle since the end of the 2007 season ... Lowered 40-yard dash time to a strong 4.55 seconds during spring practice ... Is the team's hardest runner ... Low center of gravity and breaks tackles in bunches ... Started three games in 2007 as a true freshman.

### **#53 C.J. Bryant • 6-1 • 270 • C • So.-1L • Greer, S.C. / Blue Ridge HS**

Started 10 games at center as a true freshman ... Has packed on 15 pounds of muscle in the offseason ... Should be more of an impact player in the running game in 2008 ... Excels in snapping long into GWU's shotgun sets.

### **#73 Kyle Webber • 6-5 • 275 • Jr.-2L • Jupiter, Fla. / Jupiter Christian HS**

Started eight games at right tackle in 2007 ... Will start at either right guard, left guard or right tackle in 2008 ... Versatile lineman who has improved footwork and agility ... Converted defensive tackle.

Preseason honorable mention All-America selection by ConDraft.net ... A strong NFL Draft prospect for 2009 ... Has worked very hard on conditioning since the end of spring practice ... Big South Conference Freshman of the Year in 2007 ... Set GWU record for a true freshman with 120 total tackles ... Ranked No. 2 on the Division I level (FBS and FCS) in total tackles and tackles per game among true freshmen ... Hard-nosed tackler with tremendous instincts ... A second-team All-Big South selection in 2007.

### **#20 Cedric McGowan • 6-0 • 185 • CB • Jr.-2L • Greer, S.C. / Greer HS**

2007 honorable mention All-America selection by the Sports Network ... First-team All-Big South Conference choice in 2007 ... Has excellent size and speed for a college cornerback ... Good coverage and ball skills ... Made 50 stops and led the Big South with 16 passes defended in 2007 ... Broke up 12 passes and had four interceptions.

### **#23 Daniel Cooke • 6-1 • 210 • FS • Sr.-3L • Charlotte, N.C. / Independence HS**

Three-time All-Big South Conference selection at free safety ... Has recorded 231 career tackles ... Runs well and has been a mainstay in the starting lineup since 2005 ... Has started 33 consecutive games ... Made 65 stops, had five tackles for loss and intercepted a pass in 2007 ... Also a star for the GWU baseball team ... Career leader with 68 steals ... Has .315 career BA.

### **#31 Kenny Baker • 5-11 • 270 • DT • Sr.-3L • Cartersville, Ga. / Woodland HS**

Enters third year as a starter at defensive tackle ... Has registered 93 career tackles, 15 career tackles for loss and 5.0 career sacks ... Had 36 hits, seven TFL and 2.0 sacks as a junior ... High motor interior lineman who competes hard.

### **#42 Quantavis Jackson • 5-11 • 205 • OLB • Jr.-2L • Ft. Myers, Fla. / Cypress Creek HS**

Started all 11 games at the SAM linebacker spot as a true sophomore ... Posted a career-high 67 tackles (fourth best total on team), eight tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks ... Had a 46-yard interception return for a score at VMI (10/20) ... Brke up a pair of passes and recorded a safety ... Very quick linebacker who uses long arms to his advantage in pass coverage.

Has emerged as a potential NFL prospect at linebacker ... Hard hitter and sound tackler.
