KEY STAFF/CREW

Yoshihiro Nishimura (Uniqueness modeling, make-ups, gore effects, film director)

Yoshihiro Nishimura was born in 1967. Since junior high school, he has taught himself about modeling, filming, lighting, art, and special make-up for his independent films.

In 1995, at Yubari international fantastic film festival, Nishimura received a judge special prize in the off-theater division with his independent movie, Marginal population factor. While he took charge of uniqueness modeling and make-up for many films, such as "Suicide Club" (2002) directed by Shion Sono and "MEATBALLMACHINE" (2005) directed by Yudai Yamaguchi, he established a new field in filmic visual representation called "gore effect".

Nishimura demonstrates his talent in recent Japanese films, "L change the WarLd", "Destroy Metal City", "Kai! Otokojuku", "Quiet Room ni youkoso", and so on. On the other hand, he directed his latest movie, "Tokyo Gore Police" (2008), which was planned as FEVERDREAM production, Tokyo Shock series, and this movie is waiting to be shown with high expectation as his first film-directing business in the United States.

EIHI SHIINA (as Ruka)

Born 1976 in Fukuoka.

【Biography】

She started her career as a model for UNITED COLORS OF BENETTON's world campaign when she was 18 years old. Soon she became one of the top fashion-models in Japan, showed up many fashion books, show-collections, advertisements, TV-commercials.

Her reputation was noticed in film makers, she was offered a leading role in OPEN HOUSE, playing a woman struggles for illicit love. Soon she played a bizarre heroine in Takashi Miike's horror film AUDITION, which won popularity among cult movie fan through the world, she was absorbed in acting. She specifically chose to work with unknown, but young and spirited film directors, who now lead Japanese film industry, rather than big name directors. That way, she feels more than being an actress to enhance the film itself as a creator.

Also she has a talent as a poet. In 2006, she moved to Fukuoka, where she was born, to concentrate on poetry works, which she can be back to who she is.
