Conservatives Extend Lead As Britain's Campaign Nears End

Tories now hold a six-point advantage over the Liberal Democrats; Labour stagnant at 23%.

[LONDON – May 1, 2010] – The Conservative Party has extended its advantage in Britain a few days before the General Election, a new Angus Reid Public Opinion poll conducted for the Sunday Express has found.

The online survey of a representative national sample of 1,874 British adults shows that the Liberal Democrats are holding on to second place, while the governing Liberal Party is now 12 points behind the Tories.

Voting Intention

Across Great Britain, 35 per cent of decided voters and leaners (+2) would support the Conservative candidate in their constituency in

From April 29 to April 30, 2010, Angus Reid Public Opinion conducted an online survey among 1,874 randomly selected British adults who are Springboard UK panelists. The margin of error—which measures sampling variability—is +/- 2.2%. The results have been statistically weighted according to the most current education, age, gender and region data to ensure samples representative of the entire adult population of Great Britain. Discrepancies in or between totals are due to rounding.

the 6 May General Election. The Liberal Democrats are second with 29 per cent (-1) followed by the governing Labour Party with 23 per cent (=). The United Kingdom Independence Party (UKIP) is fourth with five per cent (=), followed by the British National Party (BNP) with three per cent (+1), the Green, the Scottish National Party (SNP) and Plaid Cymru all with one per cent.
