RESOLUTION 2696

WHEREAS, WAC 392-123-054 requires that the Board of Directors of every school district meet for the purpose of fixing and adopting the budget of the district for the ensuing fiscal year.

WHEREAS, a public notice was published announcing that on August 24, 2010, the Board of Directors of East Valley School District No. 361, Spokane County, Washington, would meet in a public meeting for the purpose of fixing and adopting the 2010-2011 Fiscal Budget of the district.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of East Valley School District No. 361, Spokane County, Washington, has determined that the final appropriation level of expenditures for each fund in 2010-2011 will be as follows:

	<u>Appropriation Level</u>
A. General Fund	\$ 44,136,196
B. Transportation Vehicle Fund	\$ 220,000
C. Capital Projects Fund	\$ 0
D. Debt Service Fund	\$ 116,388
E. Associated Student Body Fund	\$ 671,628


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to RCW 28A.150.270 and WAC 392-121-445 the Board of Directors of the East Valley School District No. 361 is approving the Spokane County Treasurer to transfer \$122,194 from the General Fund to the Debt Service Fund and \$21,087 from the Transportation Vehicle Fund to the Debt Service Fund for payment of non voted bond debt; and that the Executive Director Operations, East Valley School District No. 361 be authorized to request the Spokane County Treasurer to make these approved transfers.




