1. <u>2011-2012 Proposed Final General Operating Budget</u>

Adopted the 2011-2012 Proposed Final General Operating Budget for the 2011-2012 school year with anticipated revenues of \$30,563,914 and expenditures of \$31,672,356 to include an approximate fund balance draw down of \$1,108,442. The millage will increased by .34 mills to a total of 17.34 mills.

2. 2011-2012 Proposed Final Capital Project Budget

Adopted the 2011-2012 Proposed Final Capital Project Budget in the amount of \$343,331.

1. Recognition of Visitors

Ed Winger, Varsity Softball Coach, addressed the Board in regard to concerns about the safety of the softball field.

David Smith, Head Football Coach, reported he had been approached by a group from the Oil City area who would like to hold an alumni game every summer. They planned to hold the first game July 30, 2011, in Oil City during Oil Heritage Week, with the games alternating between the two districts each summer. They would like to use district equipment for those participating. He stated the activity would raise funds for both of the school districts.

Following clarification of the request for equipment, a motion was made to allow use of the District's equipment for an alumni game between Oil City and Franklin.

2. Correspondence

Mr. Paranick shared an email he received from Darci Stitt who had addressed the Board during the Work Session, expressing her opinion of the benefits of a full-day kindergarten program.

3. Superintendent's Report

Mr. Paranick reported that Dr. Dye and he had met with Rina Nerlich, Executive Director of the Child Development Center in Franklin to discuss a cooperative program for kindergarten students in the District.

Mr. Paranick also reported that he had met with Mr. Mook and Mr. Kresenski May 19th to discuss concerns in regard to the softball field. He distributed a memo and diagram that indicted the current and suggested measurements of the fence line.

Mr. Spaid stated that dirt from the stadium renovation project was placed in the back parking area by the baseball field for possible future use on the softball field.

4. General Funds

Approved the payment of General Fund bills for April 15, 2011, through May 19, 2011, for a total amount of \$2,837,066.35.
