According to "The Questionnaire Survey on the Next-generation Child-raising Support Action Program" (intended for parents of primary school children in Numazu City), a mother spends the most time with her children in the

family and the ratio is nearly 88 %. Over half of the mothers in this city work on weekdays and about 36% of the parents think that they don't have much time to spend with their children. The conditions for working people to raise children are changing. For example, we can see the change in the introduction of a five-day week and the support for taking child-care leave. However, it is still difficult for parents to take the time to spend with their children.

"What does the time together with children give us?"

The time with children, if not long, is essential to helping children grow. If you look at stars together and watch some bugs, then your children can learn how wonderful nature is and how important life is. Financial Circumstances of Numazu City in Fiscal Year 2006

Numazu city shows citizens the 2006 fiscal year budget implementation in the general account, the special account and the business account up to March 31st, 2007. The period from April 1st to May 31st is a term for arranging revenue and expenditure, so this is not a final closing balance.

Report of the 2006 fiscal year budget implementation [General Account]



Q: What is the General Account?

A: Main revenue resources of the general account depend on the city tax such as a citizen's tax and a fixed property tax. It is used for the maintenance of roads and schools, garbage disposal, welfare and medical services, which are all directly related to the everyday lives of citizens.

- City tax: citizens tax and property tax that the citizens and corporations pay
- National treasury disbursement: subsidy and burden charge delivered by the government for special projects
- City bond: the fund the city borrowed from the central government etc. for big projects
- Prefectural treasury disbursement: subsidy and burden charge delivered by Shizuoka Prefecture
- Money transferred: the money transferred from the special accounts, etc.
- Balance brought forward: the money brought forward from the previous year
- Local consumption tax subsidy: 1% out of 5% consumption tax is distributed by the national government

[Glossary]

- Civil engineering: the expense for maintaining roads, rivers and parks, etc.
- Citizens' livelihood: the expense for the welfare of the aged and disabled, etc.
- Health and sanitation: the expense for health care, environmental sanitation and garbage disposal
- General affairs: the expense for the management of the city office, registration, tax collection and election, etc.
- Education: the expense for school education, continuing education and for promoting culture and sports
- Bonds: refund (principal and its interest) for city bonds which Numazu city borrowed from the national government in order to carry out big projects
- Fire fighting; the expense for maintenance of fire fighting vehicles and flood prevention



Up to March 31st, 2007, the rate of revenue is 90.7% and the rate of expenditure is 82.3%, compared to the budget 73,433,500,000 yen.

Q: What is the Special Account?

A: Fees such as National Health Insurance or Medical Insurance for the elderly, are paid by citizens and cover the project expenditure, so it is not necessary to use the general account. This account is called the special account.




Ms. Miwa Takada


