### **24<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific / 11<sup>th</sup> Korea National Jamboree – 2004**

We are pleased to announce that the 24<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific / 11<sup>th</sup> Korea National Jamboree, hosted by the Korea Scout Association (KSA), is well-prepared to receive your contingent. We encourage you to send a contingent to represent your national Scout organization in this Jamboree.

KSA has organized an attractive programme for your contingents. Below are the details of the Jamboree:

- Dates:** 5 August 2004 (Thu) ~ 11 August 2004 (Wed). Participants are expected to arrive on 5 August 2004 and may leave on 11 August 2004/
- Venue:** The Asia-Pacific Jamboree will be held at the 17<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree site at Mt Sorak, Kangwon Province, Korea. The Jamboree site is 315 km from Seoul (4 hours by bus). The climate in Kangwon during Jamboree is generally pleasant with occasional rain showers.
- Fee:** USD150.00 which includes rations, inland transportation, insurance, tentage, camping equipment, activities, ID card, neckerchief, and Jamboree souvenirs.
- Participants:** Boys and girls who are age between 12 and 18 and adult leader
- Programme Highlights:** Folklore and Handicraft, Orienteering, Mountaineering, Aquatic Activities, Global Development Village and City of Science
- Home Hospitality:** Participants who are willing to have more experience in Korea are welcome to apply for Home Hospitality Programme. The length of the program should not exceed 3 days, either before or after the Jamboree. This must be arranged in advance to allow the host association enough time to make necessary preparations.


