

LAKE HOLIDAY GOVERNING ORGANIZATIONS

Ideally, Lake Holiday would have just one organization responsible for managing the activities that are unique to a lake community. However, because of a variety of events that have occurred since 1962, and in order to get the things done that the residents want, three different organizations have evolved.

On March 5, 1993, the Montgomery County Circuit court approved a District Plan for the lake Holiday Conservancy District. Therefore, effective March 31, 1993, we have restructured the responsibilities of the Lake Holiday Property Owners Association (LHPOA), Holiday Utilities, Inc. (HU, Inc. dissolved in 2004), and Lake Holiday Conservancy District, (LHCD).

- **LHPOA** is a not-for-profit Indiana Corporation, primarily responsible for the roadways, housing and lot development.
- **LHCD:** an Indiana Conservancy District established under IC 14-33, is responsible for erosion, flood control, parks and water-based recreation, and operation and maintenance of their works of improvement and for future sewage / water facilities.

The LHCD owns, and is responsible for, the lake, dam, boat ramps, parks and the clubhouse and maintenance buildings.

At the present time, the schedules of Board Meetings at the clubhouse for these organizations are as follows:

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| LHPOA | 7:30 p.m., the 3 rd Monday of each Month |
| LHCD | 7:30 p.m., the 3 rd Tuesday of each Month. |
