Sensei Wakai became World Kata Champion in 1998, 2000, 2002 & 2004. She is a current World Karate Federation Kata Champion in addition to holding many Japanese national titles. She is a well-respected Seigokan [Gifu Dojo] Goju Ryu practitioner and internationally ranked athlete.

She focuses on elite International level Women's Kata Divisions. Wakai-san travels to Osaka for competition training with her male counterpart Mr. Ryoki Abe and the JKF coach Mr. Akira Shiomi Sensei. Mr. Shiomi Sensei is also the Chief Technical Director of the JKF Gojukai.

This is the first time this internationally ranked competitor will give instruction in Canada. This event is a cultural exchange, a training opportunity open to all styles of karate. The seminars are scheduled to be from March 23 to April 1, 2007 in the Lower Mainland, the Okanagan, and on Vancouver Island.
