Supervised jointly by the Ministries of Culture and Industry, École nationale supérieure de création industrielle (ENSCI) is a public institution with an industrial and commercial mission. The school specializes exclusively in design. Graduates of the program receive the diplôme de créateur industriel conferred by ENSCI-Les Ateliers.

Instruction is based on an individualized curriculum that is reassessed every six months. From the beginning of their studies students confront creative challenges in real-world projects. Students collaborate on these projects with faculty mentors, who are also practicing designers, and are often sponsored by professionals in the public or private sector.

The length of the program varies depending on the student's entry level:

- Category I: 5 years of study for students admitted with a baccalauréat (any type)
- Category II: 4 years of study for students admitted with bac + 2 (DEUG, DUT, BTS)
- Category III: 3 years of study, bac + 4 or more





• Category IV: a minimum of 3 years of study for applicants who are admitted with four or more years of professional experience.

The admissions process has two stages. A preliminary selection is made based on applicants' portfolios and letter of interest. Finalists are invited to sit for the entrance examination, which consists of a full day testing creativity and general knowledge (oral and written).
