It is such a blessing to serve with you and see God's will fulfilled on earth. At the beginning of the year, the Lord spoke to me that we are to "Manifest the Savior". He gave me four specific ways that we are to see His presence manifested:

Kenya Missions Update

In the beginning of 2007, Sharon Harris and Jeanann Stovell went to Nairobi, Kenya and took the Gritty Women of God spirit with them as women were set free and taken into new levels of freedom. In November, I took a team back to Kenya. The team consisted of myself, Pastor Terrence Stovell, Pas-

tor Nelson Bain and Erik Parise. We had the opportunity to travel "to the ends of the planet" to visit the Maasai tribe. I was deeply touched by this group of primitive people who lived in huts made of cow dung. The men protected the village by fighting off lions with essentially their bare hands. The

women did most of the work in the village. They would travel for miles and take a whole day to retrieve water from rivers infested with crocodiles and hippopotamuses; many times meeting lions and elephants along the way.

Kenya Missions Update (Cont.)

I, and the team that accompanied me had the opportunity to share the love of Jesus Christ with the entire Maasai tribe. They believe in and worship a God who created everything, but they never knew that God had a Son who came to this world and died for them because He loves them so much. We shared very basic and understandable concepts with the tribe. Water is a very scarce necessity for this group of people. A bottle of water will last two days.

God has put it upon my heart to dig a well in this region. The plan is to buy 1/2 acre of land, dig a well and then put a church on the land (the church will literally be 4 poles and a tin roof). Bishop Thomas Muthee will provide a pastor from his Bible school. When the well is dug, a village will form around it. We will give these people physical water as well as introduce them to the Living Water which is Jesus Christ.

God has placed a tremen-

dous burden on my heart, a great love for hurting, lost people. Not only the Maasai tribe but for humanity in general. This is our first step; join us! We would like to give you an opportunity to sow into this great work, aptly named "Operation Wells of Life". Any seed you can sow to this project should be made payable to ERCN, but please make it clear that it is to go to:

"Operation Wells of Life".


