

The Collapse of Evolution

COMMENTARY FROM DR. KENNEDY

In 1912, scientists discovered a human skull with a jaw like an ape. They named him Piltdown man. He was in the textbooks, encyclopedias, museums, and even the dictionaries. For example, a 1941 Webster's Collegiate Dictionary has an entry on Piltdown: "A prehistoric station in Sussex, England, yielding remains of an extinct species of man, Piltdown man (Eaonthropos dawsoni) characterized by a retreating, apelike chin and thick cranial bones, but a human-like cranium" (italics added).

He was the answer to the Darwinists' prayer, if they pray ("To whom it may concern..."). Ah, here at last was the missing link.

But in 1953, Piltdown was discovered to be a deliberate hoax. The mystery of who created it remains unsolved. The fact that men accepted it so readily—and allowed it to shape acceptance of human evolution for more than three crucial decades—points to their pro-

evolution bias. But Darwin's missing links are still missing.

We need to consider the fact that much of what we find in the scientific evidence today works against evolution, not for it. Many of the key pillars of evolution are collapsing, but because of the politically correct zeitgeist of our age, most people are not exposed to these facts.

Evolutionists today have absolutely a fit at the very thought of both sides of the origins debate being presented in school. They want evolution alone taught—and dogmatically at that. They think it is terrible that anyone would suggest such a thing as presenting both sides.

However, one writer said, "A fair result can be obtained only by fully stating and balancing the facts and arguments on both sides of each question..." To present both sides of this argument is the only way, he said, to come to a "fair result." Obviously, one would think it was some sort of

fanatical Christian who made that statement. No. As a matter of fact, it is found in Charles Darwin's *The Origin of Species*. But that has been conveniently forgotten in our time.

In his book *Icons of Evolution*, biologist Dr.

Jonathan Wells exposes as fraudulent the major showpieces evolutionists tout to prove evolution. But even though they are bogus, or there is sleight-of-hand involved, somehow these "icons of evolution" still make it into some of our science textbooks.

One of the most fundamental "icons" of evolution is Darwin's "Tree of Life." Wells notes, "[Darwin]

called it that himself, 'the great tree of life,' and by that he meant the branching pattern you would get if all living things are descended from a common ancestor. So, this common ancestry claim is right at the heart of Darwin's theory. Things were not separately created. They all descended through ordinary biological processes

from a common ancestor." All that was required was time and "descent with modification" for one common ancestor to gradually branch off into many different species.

Wells continues, "You would expect, as Darwin himself said, thousands of intermediate forms—thousands—and yet we have none. Every one of these lines [pointing from one creature to another] are just his theory, but it's presented as though it were a fact."

So where is the scientific evidence for evolution? Ask people to marshal it, and chances are, they will bring forth an example of micro-evolution—some small insignificant change within a species that is meaningless—or an example that has already been disproved. But a truly Christian world-and-life view sees evolution for what it is ... bogus science! •

Teachers Expelled for Doubting Darwin

I owa State University denied tenure to astronomy professor Guillermo Gonzalez last year, despite having scientific and academic credentials that surpassed many of his colleagues. The reason, based on statements made by Gonzalez' fellow faculty members, is his support for the view that Intelligent Design best explains the remarkable way in which physical laws are "fine-tuned" to support complex life.

There is "a ratcheting up [in the] targeting of scientists and students who express ... support for Intelligent Design," John West of The Discovery Institute, a leader in the Intelligent Design movement, told the Associated Press.

In fact, an upcoming documentary film, *Expelled: No Intelligence Allowed*, features accounts of how scholars are censored, ridiculed, or fired for questioning the evidence for evolution or advocating Intelligent Design—the view that the complexity of the cosmos and life points to a grand Designer.

"decided to put all references to evolution into only one lecture and ... give the evidence for and against evolution," Crocker said in a *Coral Ridge Hour* interview. When the class was finished, Crocker made this final remark about origins: "Is it evolution, Intelligent Design, or Creation? Think about it."

Banned

Unfortunately, Crocker's actions landed her in her supervisor's office. She was banned from lecturing and filed a grievance to protest the decision. At the end of the semester, GMU allowed her contract to expire.

"Censoring professors and students who air alternative views to evolution goes against the idea that a good education consists of providing arguments from all sides," said Brian Fisher, President of Coral Ridge Ministries. "We won't stand idly by and allow an ideology that promotes atheism to run amok in the halls of academia and influence students." •

Dr. Kennedy Messages Air in Africa

Radio broadcasts of Dr. Kennedy's messages are being aired in central Africa, fulfilling a desire Dr. Kennedy had to reach that region for Christ.

The initiative was made possible when, in February, CRM supplied a sturdy computer hard drive containing close to 1,700 *Truths That Transform* radio programs to missionary Don Warren. Warren airs Christian programs from a radio tower he erected in an area where southern Sudan, the Democratic Republic of Congo, and the Central African Republic meet.

Warren said the *Truths That Transform* programming will make it possible to preach the

Gospel and disciple believers "across boundaries such as rivers and dirt roads."

Dr. Kennedy once applied to be a missionary to the

African Congo and was turned down by a missionary board. Now, in a region where tribal drums serve as the main communication method, villagers can tune into his radio broadcast via some 1,000 solar-powered radios that serve entire clans. •

CSI Works to Counter Darwin's Influence

early 150 years after he wrote *The Origin of Species*, Charles Darwin remains a figure much-revered by scientists and academics. Niles Eldredge, the famous curator of the American Museum of Natural History, credits Darwin with being the man who "did more to secularize the Western world than any other single thinker in history."

Darwin is lionized as a champion of science in the popular high school textbook, *Biology*. The textbook devotes a chapter to Darwin and calls him "the individual who contributed more to our understanding of evolution than anyone."

But what Darwin is not venerated for are the deadly consequences that came as a result of his theory. "Evolutionary ideas fueled Hitler's Nazism and Stalin's communism," said CSI director Tom DeRosa. "Today, its consequences are evident in our society's lawlessness and immorality. No Creator means no accountability for our actions."

No God, No Rules

Closing the door on the existence of God liberates man, DeRosa said, to become his own master and lawgiver. Darwin himself acknowledged this. "A man who has no assured and ever-present belief in the existence of a personal God ... can have for his rule of life, as far as I can see, only to follow those impulses and instincts which are the strongest or which seem to him the best ones."

DeRosa, citing Scripture, noted that many have "exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator..." (Romans 1:23 NIV). Exposing the lie of evolution is CSI's mission, he said. •

MINISTRY CHANGES


The Board of Coral Ridge Ministries acted recently to cancel or postpone several initiatives, due to reduced financial revenue.
