NATIONAL CONSTITUTION COMPLETED

By three-thirty that afternoon the constitution was essentially formed and the convention as a whole met to examine it. With the help of Hussell Decker, legal advisor to Alpha, the constitution was read, discussed, and approved with one addition. Mr. Decker proposed an article which would make us a non-profit organization under the rules and regulations governing such organizations as set by the Internal Revenue Bureau and Congress. The addition was approved.
