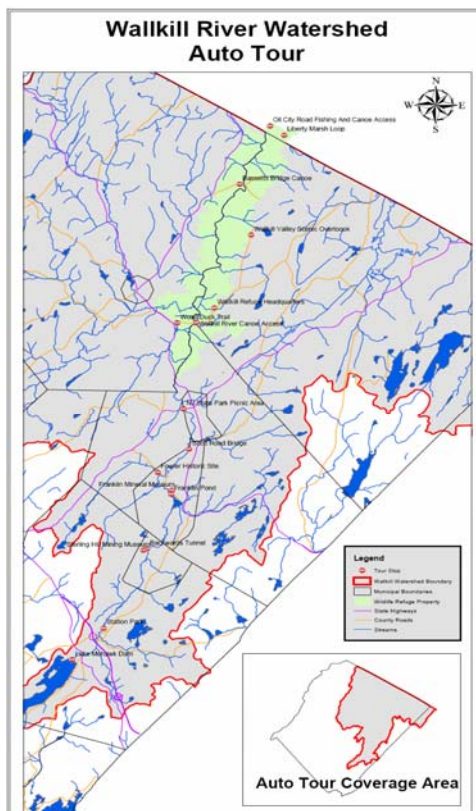
This tour will provide the opportunity to:
