Closing speech delivered at the PES Congress, Prague, 8th December 2009

I'd like to thank all our parties, our leaders and our activists, our organizations – the members of our groups in the European institutions – PES Women and ECOSY, and all those of you who are engaged in strengthening our political family.

- A clear work programme to influence the European agenda:
 - We will coordinate all our members in the European institutions and mobilise all our members in national parliaments and in the European Parliament, using the increased powers provided by the treaty;
 - We will support our parties to enter government and work intensively with all PES members in government;

- We will work with PES Women to mainstream all gender policy in our work;
- We will form a new network on Modernising politics;
- We will consolidate the role of PES activists;
- We will revitalize PES networks with the most relevant decision-makers and thinkers of our member parties and organisations;
- We will coordinate our activities and campaigns for maximum impact;
- We will stimulate grassroots engagement, through our networks, organisations, activists, and citizens' initiatives.

We will be the party of engagement, freedom and hope.

We will strengthen our political family. We will renew social democracy.

We will modernise our way of doing politics. Building the bridge between our national and our European parties.

Yes. Because we will achieve our goal of shaping progressive societies by acting together, in unison, at local, regional, national and European levels.

Becoming the natural parties of government - nationally and in Europe – to create truly progressive societies.
