<u>ORDER</u>

An election regarding the incorporation of Semmes, Alabama, a community located in Mobile County, was held on August 17, 2010, with a majority of the votes in favor of incorporating said community into a municipality.

It is **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** as follows:

1. The residents of said territory, be, and they are declared **INCORPORATED** under the laws of the State of Alabama with the name of **SEMMES**, **ALABAMA**.

2. All rights and powers granted by the laws of the State of Alabama are **CONFERRED** to said municipality.

3. The Clerk of the Court shall forward copies of this Order to all legal counsel of record, the Honorable Sam Cochran, the Honorable Marilyn Wood, the Honorable Kim Hastie, the Honorable Beth Chapman, the Honorable Sam Jones, the Mobile County Commission, the Mobile County Board of Registrars, and the Alabama Legislative Reapportionment Office by United States Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested.

4. Costs are **TAXED** to the Petitioners, **FOR WHICH LET EXECUTION ISSUE**.
