# (8) (A) CERTIFICATES OF HONOUR—(RULES)

(Conf. 415/22) (G. N. No. 773 of 7-5-26)

THE following rules governing the award of Certificates of Honour in the Straits Settlements are published for general information:-

- (1) A Certificate of Honour shall consist of a scroll, bearing the portrait of His Majesty the King and the signature and seal of His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief or of the Officer Administering the Government.
- (2) Recipients of a Certificate of Honour shall be entitled to wear around the neck, pendent from a ribbon coloured red, white and blue forty inches in length and one and a half inches wide, a silver gilt Badge, bearing on the obverse the approved. portrait of His Majesty the King, and on the reverse the armorial bearings of the Colony surrounded by the inscription in English characters "Straits Settlements."
- (3) The Badge of the Certificate of Honour may be worn on ceremonial occasions and on occasions when Orders, Decorations and Medals are worn.
- (4) Certificates of Honour shall only be awarded to persons who have resided in the Straits Settlements for a period of at least fifteen years; provided that in cases of extraordinary merit the Certificate may be awarded to persons who have so resided for a less period than fifteen years. Not more than six Certificates shall be awarded in any one year.
- (5) Notification of the award of Certificates of Honour shall ordinarily be made a special "Honours" supplement of the Government Gazette, to be published on the birthday of His Majesty the King.
- (6) At the first convenient date after such notification the recipient of a Certificate of Honour shall, on a ceremonial occasion, be invested with the ribbon and badge together with the scroll

- of a Certificate of Honour by the Governor on behalf of His Majesty the King, or by such person as he shall designate to represent him for that purpose.
- (7) If any person to whom the Certificate has been awarded shall be guilty of misconduct or of disloyalty to the Government he may be deprived of it by the Governor or Officer Administering the Government, who shall have power also to restore it to him.
- (8) Upon forfeiture of the Certificate or upon the death of any recipient the badge shall be returned forthwith to the Governor or Officer Administering the Government unless he shall in any instance deem otherwise expedient; but in no case shall the badge be worn by any other than the person to whom the Certificate was awarded.
- (9) The Governor or Officer Administering the Government is empowered to make, amend or dispense with such executive regulations, not inconsistent with these rules, as he may deem advisable for the better conduct of all matters relating to the procedure to be observed in respect of Certificates of Honour.

# (10) REGULATIONS FOR THE COLONIAL POLICE AND FIRE BRIGADES LONG SERVICE MEDAL APPLICABLE TO THE POLICE IN THE COLONY OF THE STRAITS SETTLEMENTS—

1. The Colonial Police and Fire Brigades Long Service Medal will be granted as a reward for long service and good conduct to constables and subordinate officers of the Straits Settlements Police, that is to say, to members of the Force below the rank of Inspector who on or after the 23rd day of March, 1934, shall have completed 18 years' continuous service as hereafter defined.

A bar to be attached to the ribbon by which the Medal is suspended will also be granted to a recipient of the Medal on his completing 25 years' qualifying service and a further bar on completing 30 years' qualifying service, and for each bar so awarded a small silver rose may be added to the ribbon when worn alone.

2. For the purpose of these Regulations service shall only be reckoned as qualifying service provided that the person recommended for the grant of the Medal is in possession of an exemplary character. An exemplary character requires a record of exceptionally good conduct. Whether any constable or subordinate officer has an exemplary character shall be decided by the Inspector-General of Police. Ordinarily it involves 18 years' continuous service without being convicted of being asleep on duty or of intoxication or being sentenced to confinement in a cell or to imprisonment or to a forfeiture of three or more days' pay for any misconduct.

3.—(a) Qualifying service in the Civil Police Forces of other Colonies or territories under His Majesty's protection may be allowed to reckon towards the required period of qualifying service provided that the total period of such service amounts to not less than 18 years: provided, however, that where service has been rendered in more than one such territory as aforesaid an interval not exceeding 12 months between any two periods of service shall not be regarded as breaking the continuity of such service: provided also that a break of service not exceeding six calendar months in any one such territory shall not be regarded as breaking the continuity of such service.

(b) Service in Military Police Forces shall not be regarded as qualifying service.

4. Recommendations for the award of the Medal shall be submitted by the Inspector-General of Police to the Governor or Officer Administering the Government. The Medal will be awarded on the authority of the Governor or Officer Administering the Government and a notification of such award shall be published in the Government Gazette.

5. The loss or destruction of any Medal shall, if replacement is desired, be reported by the recipient to the Inspector-General who may, if he is satisfied that the circumstances in which the loss or destruction occurred are such as to justify replacement, forward a report and recommendation for replacement to the Governor or Officer Administering the Government. No such report shall be forwarded, however, until six months after the date of the alleged loss or destruction.

6.—(a) A recipient of the Medal who is convicted of a criminal offence or is dismissed or removed from the Police Force for misconduct shall forfeit the Medal unless the Governor or Officer Administering the Government

shall otherwise direct.

(b) A Medal so forfeited may be restored to the recipient by the

Governor or Officer Administering the Government at his discretion.

(c) A notice of forfeiture or restoration shall in every case be published in the Government Gazette.

#### REGULATIONS

The following Regulations shall be observed in recommending His

Majesty to grant the Colonial Police Medal:-

(a) The Medal shall be open to all ranks of the Police Forces, civil and military, and to all members of properly organised Fire Brigades, in the Colonies and in Territories under His Majesty's Protection (including Mandated Territories).

(b) Each recommendation for the Medal shall state the name and rank of the person recommended, the Police Force or Fire Brigade of which he is or was a member, and particulars of the action or service for which the grant of the Medal is recommended.

(c) The qualifications for the Medal shall be as follows:-

(i) Conspicuous gallantry.

 (ii) Valuable service characterised by resource and devotion to duty, including prolonged service marked by exceptional ability, merit and exemplary conduct.

- (d) Any award of the Medal for conspicuous gallantry shall be made as soon as possible after the event occasioning the grant; and all other awards shall be made annually on the occasion of the celebration of His Majesty's Birthday; provided that a recommendation may be made at any time when His Majesty so commands.
- (e) The number of Medals to be awarded in any one year, for services other than conspicuous gallantry, shall not exceed one hundred and fifty save and except that in very special circumstances which, in His Majesty's opinion, would justify an exceptional grant, His Majesty may award Medals exceeding that number.

(f) The Medal shall be worn next to and immediately after the Burma

Police Medal.

(g) The award of the Medal will not be a bar to subsequent recommendation for the King's Police Medal.
