

Regional, sub-regional and local gross value added 2009



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Coverage: United Kingdom

Theme: The Economy

In 2009, London's gross value added (GVA) per head of population was 71.2 per cent above the average for the United Kingdom (UK), while that of Wales was 25.7 per cent below the average. The 2009 headline estimates show that both total GVA and GVA per head at current basic prices have fallen in all UK regions.

Regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates

GVA estimates are available for the 12 regions and countries of the UK plus Extra-Regio (see background note 7), 37 sub-regions (NUTS2) and 133 local areas (NUTS3). These estimates are consistent with the National Accounts Blue Book 2010.

Regional GVA estimates (NUTS1) for 2009 are being released for the first time along with revisions back to 1989. These estimates update those published in December 2009.


At the more detailed levels of geography (NUTS2 and NUTS3) estimates for 2008 are being released for the first time along with revisions for the period 1995 to 2007, updating the estimates published in December 2009.


Regional (NUTS1) estimates

GVA per head of population

In 2009, GVA per head of population decreased in all NUTS1 regions. The smallest decrease was in Scotland (1.4 per cent), followed by the North West (1.9 per cent). The largest decrease was seen in East of England (4.0 per cent), followed by the South East (3.5 per cent).



In 2009 negative growth occurred in every NUTS1 region, following positive growth in every region during 2008. The rate of annual growth decreased most in London (from 3.9 per cent in 2008 to -2.6 per cent in 2009). The smallest decrease in the rate of growth was in Northern Ireland (from 1.3 per cent to -2.7 per cent).



The average of annual growth in GVA per head over the period 1989 to 2009 for the UK was 4.6 per cent. London had the highest average annual growth (5.1 per cent) followed by Northern Ireland (5.0 per cent). The region with the lowest average over this period was Wales (4.0 per cent).




Of the NUTS1 regions, when compared with the UK average, only London and the South East had per head indices above the UK value in each of the years 1989, 1999 and 2009. London's per head index increased between 1989 and 1999 and between 1999 and 2009. In addition to London, Scotland (from 94.5 to 98.8 points) and the North East (from 78.1 to 78.2 points) were the only regions whose per head index increased between 1999 and 2009.

The highest index value in 2009 was in London with 171.2, followed by the South East with 104.7. The region with the lowest per head index figure in 1989 was Northern Ireland with 73.1. However, in 2009 Wales had the lowest index value with 74.3.

Total GVA

In 2009, total GVA decreased in all NUTS1 regions. The smallest decrease was in Scotland (0.9 per cent), followed by London and the North East (both at 1.5 per cent). The largest decrease occurred in the East of England (3.2 per cent).

Shares of total GVA



London and the South East had the largest regional shares of UK GVA in 2009 (21.5 per cent and 14.3 per cent respectively). Their contributions have both increased since 1989, when they accounted for 18.6 per cent and 13.3 per cent respectively. Northern Ireland (2.3 per cent) and the North East (3.3 per cent) had the smallest shares of UK GVA in 2009. The contribution of the North West has decreased the most since 1989, from 10.9 per cent to 9.6 per cent in 2009.

London and the South West are the only NUTS1 regions to have increased their share of UK GVA in each of the periods 1989 to 1999 and 1999 to 2009.



GVA per head of population

In 2008, within the 37 NUTS2 sub-regions, Inner London had the largest GVA per head (£60,686). West Wales and The Valleys had the lowest (£12,860). These figures compare with the UK average (excluding Extra-Regio) of £20,541. GVA per head grew in all NUTS2 sub-regions in 2008.



In 2008, a slowdown in the rate of annual growth was apparent in all NUTS2 sub-regions except for North Eastern Scotland, where annual growth increased from 4.3 per cent in 2007 to 4.8 per cent in 2008. The largest decrease was in Highlands and Islands, from 6.7 per cent in 2007 to 2.5 per cent, followed by Essex from 4.9 per cent to 1.0 per cent.

Total GVA

In 2008, the largest increase in total GVA was in Inner London (5.9 per cent), followed by North Eastern Scotland (5.6 percent). The smallest increases were in Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire (1.8 per cent) and West Wales and The Valleys (1.5 per cent).



GVA per head of population

Within the 133 NUTS3 areas, Inner London - West had the largest GVA per head (£107,863) in 2008. Isle of Anglesey had the smallest (£11,333). These figures compare with the UK average (excluding Extra-Regio) of £20,541.

NUTS3: GVA per head growth on previous year, 2007 and 2008




When comparing the five NUTS3 areas with the highest GVA per head in 2008 against those with the lowest GVA per head in 2008, the annual growths for the former are generally stronger in both 2007 and 2008.

In 2008, a slowdown in the rate of annual growth was evident in all 133 NUTS3 areas except for Aberdeen City and Aberdeenshire, where growth increased from 4.3 per cent in 2007 to 4.8 per cent in 2008. The largest decrease was in Falkirk, from 6.8 per cent in 2007 to 1.2 per cent in 2008.

Total GVA

In 2008, total GVA grew in all NUTS3 areas except for East Sussex CC (-0.2 per cent) and South and West Derbyshire where it remained unchanged. The largest increase on 2007 was in Inner London - West (6.0 per cent) followed by Inner London - East (5.7 per cent).

Variation within regions



The chart above illustrates the extent of variation in GVA per head within NUTS1 regions in 2008. The NUTS3 local areas with the highest and lowest GVA per head within each NUTS1 region determine the range of GVA per head within that region.

London has the most variation, ranging between Outer London – East and North East (£13,911) and Inner London – West (£107,863). Scotland has the next highest amount of variation, between East Ayrshire and North Ayrshire Mainland (£12,327) and Edinburgh (£34,562).

The region with the least variation is the North East region of England, between Northumberland (£12,624) and Darlington (£19,266).

Future work plans

ONS plans to publish estimates of regional GVA for 1989 to 2010 and sub-regional and local GVA for 1995 to 2009 in December 2011.

The new Eurostat NACE Rev2 and its UK equivalent, the Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (UK SIC2007) will be implemented in the UK National Accounts (and therefore GDP) in September 2011 in line with EU regulations. This new classification will be implemented in the regional GVA estimates in December 2011, also in line with EU regulation.

The publication of regional household income estimates for the period 1995 to 2009 is currently planned for March 2011.

Annex A: Diversity of the NUTS1 regions

Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Government Office Regions of England have differing demographic characteristics, industrial structure and economic performance.

Scotland has the largest area, but a relatively small population; London has the smallest area, but the second largest percentage of the population (12.5 per cent). At the other extreme, Northern Ireland (2.9 per cent) has the lowest percentage of the UK total. These variations in regional populations are reflected in the size of regional GVA and incomes.

The wide variation in the size of the regions makes it difficult to compare the regional economic performance using cash totals. Comparisons are therefore usually expressed in terms of amounts per head of the population. Growth in totals may be quite different from the growth per head in regions where the population has increased or decreased. Furthermore, the level per head is determined both by the average amount of income of the working population and by the proportion of the population who are economically inactive. Some regions will have a relatively high proportion of children, which will tend to depress amounts per head. For productivity analysis the age structure of the population should be taken into account.

Basic quality information

2. A Summary Quality Report for regional GVA can be found at www.statistics.gov.uk/about_ns/economicstatistics_qualityreports.asp. This report describes, in detail, the intended uses of the statistics presented in this publication, their general quality and the methods used to produce them.

Relevance to users

3. The Nomenclature of Units for Territorial Statistics (NUTS) provides a single uniform breakdown for the production of regional statistics for the European Union. There are three levels of NUTS in the UK:
 - NUTS1: Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Government Office Regions of England.
 - NUTS2: 37 areas – mainly groups of counties and unitary authorities; can be referred to as sub-regions.
 - NUTS3: 133 areas – principally individual counties and unitary authorities; also known as local areas.
 - Some areas appear at more than one level, for example Northern Ireland appears at NUTS1 and NUTS2 level.
4. The NUTS1 GVA estimates presented here are on a workplace basis (allocated to where the economic activity takes place). Residence based estimates, where earnings of individuals are allocated to the region in which they live, are also published at NUTS1 level.
5. Estimates are presented in current basic prices, in other words, they do not allow for different regional price levels or changes in prices over time (inflation).
6. The headline regional GVA series have been calculated using a 5-year, weighted moving average technique. These adjusted series remove some year to year volatility in the unadjusted series. The unadjusted series are also provided for information on the National Statistics website: <http://www.statistics.gov.uk/statbase/Product.asp?vlnk=14650>
7. The contribution to GVA of UK embassies abroad and UK forces stationed overseas is included in Extra-Regio, along with the elements relating to activities taking place on the continental shelf. As these cannot be assigned to specific regions they are assigned as

Extra-Regio GVA. The statistical discrepancy is the difference between the sum of the national income components and the definitive national estimate of GVA.

8. GVA per head is a useful way of comparing regions of different sizes and is an important indicator for both domestic and European policy purposes. It is not, however, a measure of regional productivity, as the population estimates used to calculate it include the economically inactive population. ONS produces estimates of regional GVA per filled job and GVA per hour worked in the Productivity Statistical Bulletin.

Common pitfalls in interpreting series

9. Very few statistical revisions arise as a result of 'errors' in the popular sense of the word. All estimates, by definition, are subject to statistical 'error' but in this context the word refers to the uncertainty in any process or calculation that uses sampling, estimation or modelling. Most revisions reflect either the adoption of new statistical techniques or the incorporation of new information which allows the statistical error of previous estimates to be reduced. Only rarely are there avoidable 'errors' such as human or system 'errors' and such mistakes are made clear when they are discovered and corrected.

Accuracy

10. Figures for 2009 are provisional and data for all years are subject to revisions in light of revised National Accounts Blue Book data in future years.

Revisions

11. Revisions to NUTS1 regional GVA estimates in this statistical bulletin cover the period 1989 to 2008. Revisions to NUTS2 and NUTS3 estimates cover the period 1995 to 2007.

The main reasons for revisions are detailed below:

In the UK National Accounts Blue Book 2010, the totals for national GVA by industry were revised as far back as 2006. These lead to revisions in the regional data, which are constrained to the national figures.

PAYE data from Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC), used in the compilation of compensation of employees estimates, were revised for 2007/8 and new estimates supplied for 2008/9.

Final estimates for 2008 became available from the Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings, the Annual Business Inquiry and other data sources.

ONS mid-year estimates of population data have been revised back to 2002, causing revisions in GVA per head estimates and GVA per head indices. For more information see:

Updates to other minor data sources have caused small revisions to earlier periods.

Reliability

12. As with the national accounts, regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates are calculated as reliably as possible. There is no easy way to measure the reliability of the estimates but ONS carries out consistency checks on data inputs, applies methods consistently and makes use of local knowledge for England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. The estimates are partly based on sample surveys and the quality of the results therefore varies according to sample size. This means that the results for smaller regions are subject to a greater degree of uncertainty than those for larger regions.

13. Rounding: The sum of constituent items in tables may not always agree exactly with the totals shown due to rounding.
14. Symbols: - Nil or less than half the final digit shown.
