- **Two GPA's listed on transcript:** **GPA (1)** is: the official BHS GPA, used to calculate class rank, and includes only honors points earned in 2010-11 school year. **GPA (2)** is calculated weighting all honors classes taken, including courses taken prior to the change in policy. No rankings will be calculated using **GPA (2)**.
