THE GAME • Western Michigan heads to Buffalo, N.Y., for only the second time and first since a 2002 match up - a 31-17 Bronco win. WMU is coming off its 500th program win, a 41-20 defeat of Ohio, and will now finish the month of October on the road during the next two weeks.

TELEVISION • The game will be televised regionally on Time Warner Sports Network. This station is available only in the Buffalo area. If you live in the Buffalo area, please contact your cable provider for local listings. The game will be available to Bronco Insider subscribers. Please visit the home page at www.wmubroncos.com to join.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play), calling WMU football games in his 25th season, and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past 10 seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page.

SERIES IN BRIEF • The Broncos and Bulls have only met on the field three times in this series with WMU holding a 3-0 edge. The last meeting came during Bill Cubit's first season (2005), resulting in a 31-21 win. That game also marked the collegiate debut of Tim Hiller.

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his fourth season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 25-17 overall (.595), 14-5 at Waldo Stadium (.737), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 following the 2006 season. Cubit has led WMU to road wins over BCS conference teams such as Virginia and Iowa during his tenure, outscoring those teams, 45-29.

Turner Gill (Nebraska, 1990) is in his third season as the head coach of the Buffalo football program. During the 2007 season, Gill earned Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading the Bulls to five wins - the most in its Division I-A history. The program had won 10 games in its first seven years in I-A, they won half of that total in '07. UB finished with a 5-3 conference record, including a 4-2 mark in the MAC East Division to claim a share of the regular season title. Prior to the 2007 campaign, UB had won eight MAC games total in the previous eight years.

UP NEXT • Western Michigan will make the three-hour trek to Mount Pleasant, Mich., on Oct. 18 for the annual showdown between these two Mid-American Conference West Division, and in-state, rivals. This game will be WMU's first trip to Kelly/Shorts Stadium since the 2006 season and it will also be the Broncos' last game in the month of October.

GAME 7 – WESTERN MICHIGAN AT BUFFALO – GAME NOTES

LANDMARK WIN . Western Michigan's win over Ohio marked the 500th in program history. It also matched the Broncos' overall and Mid-American Conference win totals from 2007. It was WMU's third win in as many games at Waldo Stadium this season.

DECISIVE • WMU's 21-point victory over Ohio was its largest margin of victory over the Bobcats since claiming a 26-point (35-9) in Waldo Stadium on on Sept. 28, 1991. It was also the Broncos' largest win over a MAC opponent since Sept. 23, 2006 when Western Michigan defeated Temple, 41-7.

AND BOOM GOES THE DYNAMITE . WMU has a tradition of shooting off Boomer the Cannon after each score and that has been one busy (and loud) cannon in 2008. The Broncos' 41 points against Ohio marked the third time this season WMU has scored 40 or more points in a game and the 11th time during the Bill Cubit era.

The three games with 40 or more points in 2008 is one shy of the team's 2005 effort when the Broncos scored 40 or more points in four-consecutive games.

WMU has scored 111 points at Waldo Stadium so far this season (37.0 points per game) against 82 points on the road. The Broncos scored 31.0 points per game at home in 2007, 26.6 per game in 2006 and 39.4 per game in 2005.

SAFETY DANCE · Western Michigan recorded its second safety of the season when Zach Davidson brought down Ohio's Boo Jackson in his own end zone. The Broncos' first came at Idaho on Sept. 13 and was recorded by true freshman Josh Price.

Price's safety was the program's first since another true freshman, Louis Delmas, recorded a safety for WMU against Kent State on Oct. 29, 2005 at Waldo Stadium. That had been the first safety for the program since Jack Gitler had one against Northern Illinois on Oct. 20, 2001 (also his true fresman season).

The last time Western Michigan had two safeties in a season was 1996. Both occurred on punts where the snap went out of the end zone and were credited to the team. The first occurred in the second game of the season at West Virginia (Sept. 7, 1996) and the second at home against Ball State (Oct. 5, 1996).

PASS HAPPY • Tim Hiller completed 64.9 percent of his passes for 347 yards (ninth 300-yard game of career) and four TD passes (17th multi-TD game of career) in WMU's 41-20 win over Ohio on Homecoming. Hiller connected for scores to a tight end, a wide receiver and two to a running back. He also rushed for 51 yards, including a 39-yard run for a first down. Hiller now has 19 TD passes on the season (59 for his career) and just 4 INTs. He has 1,701 yards passing half way through the season.

ONE IF BY LAND, TWO IF BY ... AIR • For the second week in a row a member of the Western Michigan football team has earned a weekly award from the Mid-American Conference. This week junior Brandon West was named the MAC West Special Teams Player of the Week thanks to his 239 all-purpose yard performance in WMU's 41-20 win over Ohio.

West amassed 239 all-purpose yards, recording at least 60 yards in kick returns (60), receiving (72) and rushing (107). West scored a touchdown rushing and two receiving for the first three-TD game of his career. It also marked the first time in his career he had more than one receiving TD in one game. West scored on a screen pass from 18 yards out on his first and took another screen 45 yards down the home side line for another. His running score came late in the fourth quarter from 26 yards out to put WMU back up by three touchdowns.

The Brunswick, Ga., native had his third 100-yard rushing game of the season and eighth of his career. He now has 574 yards on 103 carries (5.6) so far this season, leading the team with 95.7 rushing yards per game. He leads the team and the conference in all-purpose yards at 1,027 (171.2 per game). During the game he also matched Elan Banks for second-most kick returns in program history (71).

68 CC's OF DEFENSE • The Milwaukee Brewers' CC Sabathia's season may be done but WMU's CC (Cody Cielenski) is just getting started. In three games this season, Cielenski has amassed 3.5 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks to go along with 11 tackles. He was one off his career with five stops against Ohio but did set career marks in sacks and TFLs with 2.0 each.

PICK 'EM • The Western Michigan defense had its second game of the season with two interceptions (first was in the season opener at Nebrasak), recording the team's fifth and sixth picks of of the year. Harrison Porter recorded his first career interception on the game's opening drive, returning it 31 yards. C.J. Wilson recorded his second interception of the year and eighth of his career as well.

MARKO ... **POLO** • Jamarko Simmons led WMU's receiving attack against Ohio with eight receptions for 87 yards and one touchdown. Simmons, who is just one catch away from becoming only the third Bronco with 200 receptions in program history, has been the team's leader in receiving yards five out of the Broncos' six games so far this season.

Simmons, who also leads the team with five receiving TDs, has had at least 80 yards receiving in four of six games and 60 or more yards in five of six games. The only game Simmons did not lead in receiving yards was against Nebraska when Branden Ledbetter had nine catches for 123 yards.

Simmons has 43 catches through six games, 7.2 receptions per game. Holding onto that average for the remainder of the season would give him 242 career receptions and the record for most career receptions, four better than current record holder Greg Jennings.

POWER UP • For the second week in a row Western Michigian finds itself in ESPN.com's Non-BCS Power Rankings. The Broncos entered the top 10 on Sept. 29 at No. 7 and after a 41-20 win over Ohio, find themselves at No. 9.

REMEMBER WHEN • The last time Western Michigan faced Buffalo was Oct. 1, 2005. It was also the first time then true freshman Tim Hiller stepped onto a field during a collegiate game.

Hiller's debut began with the start of the second half against the Bulls. He threw seven passes, connecting on only three of them but two went for touchdowns.

EDGE OF REASON • WMU'S E.J. Biggers came off the edge on Ohio's point-after attempt in the fourth quarter, blocking the kick. It was Biggers' first career block and the Broncos' first PAT block since Nick Varcadipane accomplished the feat on Nov. 5, 2005 against Eastern Michigan. since Cory Flom's record-breaking season of 2006 when he blocked four kicks, including a field goal in the regular season finale at Akron on Nov. 24, 2006.

From 2002 through this season, WMU is among the nation's best in blocked kicks with 21. Fourteen of those came in 2005 and 2006.

READY IN FIVE MINUTES OR LESS • Western Michigan is tied for seventh in the country in touchdown drives of five minutes or less. The Broncos, with 11, share the seventh spot with Florida State and are two in back of No. 3/2 Missouri (13) and seven shy of the mark currently being set by undefeated Tulsa (18).

WMU cracked into the top 10 thanks in part to its five touchdown drives of under five minutes against Ohio. The Broncos matched their quickest scoring drive of the season against the Bobcats, putting it in the end zone one minute, 21 seconds after taking possession.

FUMBLEROOSKI • Western Michigan's defense has forced seven fumbles this season with the opposition coughing up the ball on four of those forces. John Potter caused his second fumble of the season against Ohio, which resulted in a Tim Hiller to Jamarko Simmons touchdown.

The Broncos have scored 31 points off turnovers so far this season with drives starting with a take away resulting a touchdown four times and a field goal once.

MOVERS AND SHAKERS . Western Michigan welcomed four new coaches to its staff prior to the 2008 season.

Mike Grant - Grant came to WMU after spending a season at Southern Miss and following nine season at Iowa State.

Rick Kravitz - Kravitz comes to WMU after spending a season as the defensive coordinator at Memphis. He brings 23 years of experience to Kalamazoo.

Mike Sabock - Sabock spent 24 seasons with MAC rival Northern Illinois under legendary head coach Joe Novak.

Ryan Cubit - Cubit, finishing graduate school, is in his first season with the Broncos as a member of the coaching staff, working with WMU's quarterbacks.

SILVER ANNIVERSARY . The Voice of Bronco Athletics, Robin Hook, is in his 25th year of calling Western Michigan games on the Bronco Radio Network. He has called two of the three postseason bowl games in WMU football history.

THE HOST WITH MOST • Western Michigan football will host a home game at Ford Field for the first time when the Broncos take on Illinois (currently ranked No. 19) on Nov. 8. The Broncos will continue the relationship with the Big Ten in 2009 when Michigan State is scheduled to take the field against WMU at the home of Detroit Lions.

HOW THEY SEE IT • Western Michigan was chosen to finish third in the MAC West Division by the MAC News Media Association but did receive a pair of first place votes.

West Division (6-5-4-3-2-1 Point System)
