## WESTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY BRONCOS (6-2, 4-1 MAC) VS. EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY EAGLES (2-7, 1-4 MAC)



November 1, 2008 • Waldo Stadium • 2 p.m.

**THE GAME** • Western Michigan returns from its bye week to host Eastern Michigan at Waldo Stadium. The Broncos are looking for their seventh overall win of their year and fifth in the Mid-American Conference.

The game will celebrate the induction of the WMU Athletic Hall of Fame Class of 2008. The six-member class includes former football coach Al Molde. The 1988 MAC Championship team will also be reunited this weekend in honor of their conference title and trip to the California Bowl.

**RADIO** • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play), calling WMU football games in his 25th season, and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past 10 seasons.

**WEB SITE** • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site ([www.wmubroncos.com](http://www.wmubroncos.com)) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page.

**SERIES IN BRIEF** • Western Michigan holds the series edge, 26-15-2, with a 19-8-1 edge over the Eagles at Waldo Stadium. EMU was victorious in the last meeting and the Eagles are

looking for their first back-to-back wins over Western Michigan since 1990-91. EMU's longest win streak in the series is three games (1989-91) but the Broncos hold the longest win streak in the series with seven straight from 1997-2003.

**THE COACHES** • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his fourth season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 26-18 overall (.591), 14-5 at Waldo Stadium (.737), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 following the 2006 season. Cubit has led WMU to road wins over BCS conference teams such as Virginia and Iowa during his tenure, outscoring those teams, 45-29.

Jeff Genyk (Bowling Green, 1982) is in his fifth season at the helm of the Eastern Michigan football program. He has an overall record of 15-40 with the Eagles and is coming off a 4-8 season in 2007, one that saw EMU and WMU tie in the MAC West Division standings at 3-4. Eastern Michigan is the current holder the Michigan MAC Trophy awarded to either WMU, EMU or CMU depending on which team has the best record in the round-robin schedule.

**UP NEXT** • Western Michigan will host Illinois at Ford Field on Nov. 8. The Broncos have never hosted a team at the professional venue, and home to the Detroit Lions. WMU has played in the venue once before. On Nov. 5, 2005 Western Michigan defeated Eastern Michigan, 44-36. The game will be surrounded with events throughout the day and week leading up to the match up. **WELCOME TO THE CLUB** • The Western Michigan Athletic Hall of Fame will induct the Class of 2008 on Nov. 1 during halftime of the Eastern Michigan game. The class is comprised of six members (four males and two females), featuring two from track & field and one each from hockey, baseball, women's tennis and football.

**20** **BACK TOGETHER AGAIN** • The game on Nov. 1 against Eastern Michigan also marks the reunion of Western Michigan's 1988 Mid-American Conference Championship and California Bowl team. Currently over 50 members from that team plan on attending not only Saturday's game but also the Hall of Fame reception on Friday, as well as the Al Molde reception being held in the Gill Club - also being held on Friday evening.

**30** That 1988 team not only achieved WMU's only outright MAC football title in program history and the second of three bowl appearances ever, but also a mountain's worth of individual accolades as well.

**40** **RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN** • Tim Hiller had another record-breaking day against Central Michigan, breaking the school record for passing yards in a game with 471. It was the first time a WMU quarterback had thrown for over 400 yards since Chad Munson accomplished the feat on Sept. 6, 2003 against William & Mary.

**50** Hiller also broke the stadium record for pass completions (38), pass attempts (53) and yards (471) at Kelly/Shorts Stadium. It marked the second-straight week that Hiller had set a stadium mark on the road after setting the UB Stadium (Buffalo) record for pass attempts (63), also a WMU school record.

**40** Hiller is averaging 314.6 passing yards this season and is on pace to throw for 1,258 more over the final four regular season games. If that pattern holds true, Hiller will finish with 3,775 yards, which would not only be a career high but would break Tim Lester's record from 1999 (3,639).

**30** He is also on pace to throw 37 touchdown passes this season, which would break another one of Lester's records - 34 touchdown passes in 1999.

**TIMMY!** • Tim Hiller and Tim Lester are side by side in career 300-yard passing games as the former had the 10th of his career against Central Michigan. The latter still holds the lead with an astonishing 16 career 300-yard passing games.

**20** **THINGS COME IN THREE'S** • Against CMU, Western Michigan had three receivers with 100 yards in a game for only the second time in school history and first time since Sept. 4, 1999 against No. 4 Florida.

**FRIENDLY NEIGHBORHOOD SPYDA MAN** • Senior wide out Schneider “Spyda” Julien has 491 yards receiving through eight games but nearly half of those yards have come in the past two games. Entering the game at Buffalo, Julien had 252 yards on 20 receptions. Against the Bulls and Central Michigan, Julien has hauled in 19 catches for 239 yards.

**AND MARKO WAS HIS NAME-O** • Jamarko Simmons has 66 receptions for 702 yards through two-thirds of the 2008 season. He is on pace to become only the seventh Bronco to finish with 1,000 yards in a season (1,053) and to top the record for receptions in a season with 99.

The man he is chasing in both categories should be playing in Honolulu in February. Greg Jennings is the last Bronco to reach the millennium mark with 1,259 yards in 2005. He is also the current record holder for receptions in a season with 98, also coming in WMU’s turnaround season of 2005.

Simmons is also just 18 catches from becoming Western Michigan’s career leader in receptions, sitting at 222 and looking up at Jennings’ mark of 239.

**SPREAD THE WEALTH** • Western Michigan has 25 touchdowns through the air this season and even though Jamarko Simmons has nearly a quarter of those (6), eight different Broncos have at least one TD reception, six have at least two and five at three or more

**GIVING THEM THE RUN AROUND** • Brandon West leads the team with nine touchdowns this season and by far leads with six rushing TDs. He recorded his first career multi-rushing TD game with two against Central Michigan. He had his first career multi-receiving TD game earlier this season with two against Ohio on Oct. 4.

**DO WORK** • West’s nine total TDs has already bested his previous career best for a season (six in 2007) but he has a substantial amount of work to do before he surpasses the school record for TDs in a season shared by Sam Dunlap and Jerome Persell who each recorded 19 touchdowns in 1916 and 1976, respectively.

**AUSTIN, WE HAVE NO PROBLEM** • Junior linebacker Austin Pritchard recorded the third double-digit tackle performance of his career with a career-best 17 stops against Central Michigan. Pritchard last had 10 or more tackles in a game in his only appearance of 2007 with 11 against West Virginia. His first came

on Oct. 8, 2005 against Ball State when he had 14 stops (eight solo).

Pritchard’s 17-tackle performance against CMU has moved him into second place on the team with 50 total stops this season behind team leader Louis Delmas with 64.

**ANOTHER GAME, ANOTHER TROPHY** • Western Michigan’s last game marked the first time in the history of the WMU-CMU rivalry that a trophy was involved. This week’s game against Eastern Michigan marks another game in the fight for the Michigan MAC Trophy sponsored by the Michigan Sports Hall of Fame, which was introduced in 2005.

During its three-year history, each of the three Michigan schools in the Mid-American Conference have possessed the hardware for a year. The Eagles are the current holders of the trophy.

WMU is one game down in the battle for the Michigan MAC Trophy and if all of the teams go 1-1 against one another, Eastern Michigan will retain it.

**TAKE A BREAK** • After the Broncos host Eastern Michigan on Nov. 1, the Eagles will not play a game for three calendar weeks. EMU will travel to Temple on Nov. 22 before closing the season at Rynearson Stadium against in-state MAC West rival Central Michigan.

**BOUNCE BACK** • Under head coach Bill Cubit, Western Michigan is 5-2 in MAC games after a MAC loss. The only times under Cubit where the Broncos did not come back to play a MAC team the week after a MAC loss was 2006 when the Broncos fell, 20-28, at Florida State and in 2007 when WMU went into Iowa City and took a 28-19 win from Iowa. In 2006, WMU closed the season with a 17-0 shut out at Akron to bounce back from its MAC loss two weeks earlier, en route to the International Bowl.

**MOVERS AND SHAKERS** • Western Michigan welcomed four new coaches to its staff prior to the 2008 season.

**Mike Grant** - Grant came to WMU after spending a season at Southern Miss and following nine season at Iowa State.

**Rick Kravitz** - Kravitz comes to WMU after spending a season as the defensive coordinator at Memphis. He brings 23 years of experience to Kalamazoo.

**Mike Sabock** - Sabock spent 24 seasons with MAC rival Northern Illinois under legendary head coach Joe Novak.

**Ryan Cubit** - Cubit, finishing graduate school, is in his first season with the Broncos as a member of the coaching staff, working with WMU's quarterbacks.
