THE GAME • Western Michigan will attempt to finish its home schedule at Waldo Stadium undefeated for the 10th time in program history and for the third time this decade when Toledo visits Kalamazoo on Nov. 15. This will be the latest meeting between the two teams since facing one another on Nov. 22, 2003.

A win over Toledo would give Western Michigan a nine-win season for only the second time in program history, matching the effort of the 1988 MAC Championship team and the 2000 MAC West Division Championship team.

TELEVISION • This game will be televised on Fox Sports Net in Ohio and in Michigan. In Michigan will be able to view the game on FSN + and in Kalamazoo area, those that have Charter Cable, and are not able to attend in person, can watch the action on channel 88. It is channel 901 on Comcast, 664 on DirecTV and between channel 445-453 on Dish Network. You must have digital cable to view the game. Please check local listings for the specific channel in your area. Michael Reghi (play-by-play) and Mike Pagel (analysis) will have the call.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play), calling WMU football games in his 25th season, and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past 10 seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page.

SERIES IN BRIEF • Western Michigan trails Toledo in the all-time series, 26-36-0, and looks to even the series when playing at Waldo Stadium with the Rockets holding a slight 16-15-0 edge. The Broncos are looking for their third-straight win over Toledo, a feat that has not been accomplished in 30 years (1976-78).

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his fourth season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 28-18 overall (.609), 15-5 at Waldo Stadium (.750), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 following the 2006 season. Cubit has led WMU to road wins over BCS conference teams such as Virginia and Iowa during his tenure and is coming off a win over Illinois at Ford Field. His teams have outscored those opponents, 68-46.

Tom Amstutz (Toledo, 1977) is in eighth and final season as the head coach of the Toledo Rockets after it was announced he would step down at the end of the 2008 season to take a position in Toledo's alumni relations office. The Rockets are 57-39 under Amstutz heading into the match up with Western Michigan.

UP NEXT • Western Michigan will close out its regular season with a showdown against nationally ranked Ball State at Scheumann Stadium in Muncie, Ind. The Broncos are coming off a four-point loss to the Cardinals in 2007 but were victorious over BSU during WMU's last visit to Muncie, 41-27.

GAME 11 – WESTERN MICHIGAN VS. TOLEDO – GAME NOTES

WE SALUTE YOU • The Western Michigan University Athletic Department is partnering with the WMU Advocacy Office for Military Affairs and the Military and Veteran's Student Association to collect donations for care packages that will be sent to deployed WMU faculty, staff, students and alumni. Donations will be accepted at the Advocacy Office located in the Berhard Center, as well as at the WMU Football game on Nov. 15.

A SENIOR MOMENT • Western Michigan will acknowledge 26 seniors prior to the kick off against Toledo on Nov. 15. This is the largest senior class under head coach Bill Cubit and it has the chance to do something no other senior class has done - take WMU to two bowl games.

A SWEEPING SUCCESS • For the first time this season, Western Michigan swept the Mid-American Conference West Division Player of the Week awards as Jamarko Simmons (Offense), Louis Delmas (Defense) and John Potter (Special Teams) were all honored for their performance in WMU's win over Illinois.

Simmons had 11 receptions for a career-high 174 yards in WMU's 23-17 win over Illinois. He broke Greg Jennings' career receptions record. He also became the first Bronco with 1,000 yards receiving in a season since Jennings in 2005. This is the second MAC West POTW nod of Simmons' career.

Delmas registered his fifth double-digit tackle effort of the 2008 season, recording a career-matching 12 tackles against Illinois. Delmas has had 10 or more tackles in each of the last two games after starting the year with three-straight games with 10 or more stops. He leads the team with 87 tackles and is 13 tackles away from becoming the first Bronco to have 100 in a season since 2003. This is the second MAC West POTW of the season for Delmas.

Potter was 3-for-3 on field goals, making attempts of 31, 22 and 45 yards, respectively. Potter's 45-yard field goal five seconds into the fourth quarter was his first-career attempt of over 40 yards and pushed WMU's lead to six, forcing Illinois to have to drive for a touchdown instead of game-tying field goal. He was also 2-for-2 in PATs. This was Potter's first MAC West POTW award of his young career.

SIGNATURE WIN • Western Michigan's 23-17 win over Illinois marked the third time in as many seasons that the Broncos have defeated a team from a BCS conference and the second time in as many seasons that WMU has beaten a Big Ten away from Waldo Stadium (even though the game against the Illini was WMU's home game at Ford Field).

In each of the past two occasions, the teams did not make a bowl game that season. Virginia finished 5-7, one win away from eligibility. Iowa finished 6-6, bowl eligible but was left out of the bowl picture at the conclusion of the 2007 season. With the loss, Illinois fell to 5-5 and in need of at least one more win in its remaining two games to secure a postseason bowl berth.

HELPING OUT THE CAUSE • The win also marked a milestone for the Mid-American Conference. It was the fourth MAC win over a Big Ten team this season, breaking the old mark set in 2003.

In 2003, Ohio defeated Minnesota, Western Michigan beat Iowa, and Bowling Green defeated Purdue. In 2003, Miami won over Northwestern and Bowling Green beat Northwestern in the regular season, and Bowling Green beat Northwestern in the post season (Motor City Bowl).

Also claiming wins over Big Ten teams this season are Ball State and Central Michigan over Indiana, and Michigan over Toledo.

IN THE POLLS • Western Michigan is receiving in-season votes in the *Associated Press* and *USA Today/Coaches* Poll for the first time since 2000 after its 23-17 win over Illinois at Ford Field. The Broncos also received two votes in the *Associated Press* Poll prior to the 2001 season.

The Broncos are receiving six votes in the *Associated Press* Poll, tied with Oregon for 31st and receiving five votes in the *USA Today/Coaches* Poll, tied with Miami (Fla.)

and West Virginia at 40th. This is the first time since WMU finished the 2000 campaign at 9-3 and in the Mid-American Conference Championship that Western Michigan has made an appearance in either poll. The Broncos climbed as high as 26th in the polls eight seasons ago.

Western Michigan is one of three MAC teams either ranked or receiving votes in this week's polls with Ball State (9-0, 5-0 MAC) ranked No. 14/16 and Central Michigan (7-2, 5-0 MAC) receiving votes in the AP Poll (5).

CONSISTENCY IS THE KEY • With the win over Illinois, Western Michigan has reached the eight-win mark for the sixth time in program history and second time during Bill Cubit's tenure as coach. In fact, the 28 wins under Cubit match the previous four-year record from 1998-2001 and is three away from the highest four-year win total in program history, 31 from 1997-2000.

PASSING THE TORCH • Jamarko Simmons cemented his place in Western Michigan football history with an 11-catch, 174-yard career high performance against Illinois. His 11 grabs gives him 240 for his career, a new WMU record, surpassing Greg Jennings in the process.

His 174 yards, his third career game of 170 or more yards receiving, pushed him just over the 1,000-yard mark in a season for the first time in his career and made him the first Bronco to reach that mark since ... Greg Jennings in 2005. In fact, Simmons is only the seventh Bronco to accomplish the feat and he is 256 yards from surpassing Jennings for most receiving yards in a season (1,259).

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING • Simmons also became the first Bronco in program history to have two seasons with 80 or more receptions. He has 84 catches this season, matching his total from 2007. He has at least two more games to surpass Greg Jennings' mark of 98 set in 2005, also having the opportunity to become WMU's first-ever receiver with 100 receptions in a season. If he could do that, he would be only the sixth player in MAC history to do so and third in the past two seasons.

PROPS FROM THE WORDWIDE LEADER • For his effort against Illinois, Simmons received a helmet sticker on ESPN's College Game Day Final and from ESPN.

com's Graham Watson. Simmons is the third Bronco in as many seasons to receive the honor, joining Ameer Ismail (2006) and Tim Hiller (2007).

ORRVILLE'S OWN • Tim Hiller became only the second Bronco to have 3,000 yards passing in two seasons, matching Tim Lester's effort. Like Lester, Hiller has done it in back-to-back campaigns. His yards, now at 3,157, matched with Jamarko Simmons' 1,004 yards receiving gives WMU its first 3,000-yardpasser and 1,000-yard receiver since 1999.

He is currently ranked second in the nation in pass completions (283), third in attempts (412), fifth in the country in touchdowns (30), third in completions per game (28.30), eighth in points responsible for per game (19.40) and ninth in total offense per game (316.90).

He has set school records for completions (42), attempts (63) and passing yards (471) in a game so far this season and just set the school record for completions in a season (283). Hiller has thrown for 300 yards or more seven times this year and in each of last five games.

CHALK UP ANOTHER ONE • Nine games into his junior season, Brandon West is already the career record holder for kick offs (82) and kick off return yards (2,049). After his 178 all-purpose yardage performance against Illinois, West can now had career all-purpose yards record holder as well, surpassing Greg Jennings previous mark of 5,093 yards. West now has 5,194 and is also just 91 yards from the first 1,000-yard rushing season of his career.

A CHANCE FOR SOMETHING SPECIAL • A win over Toledo on Nov. 15 would achieve to special moments in WMU football history. A win would mark the 10th undefeated season at Waldo Stadium, which would also be the third this decade and the second under Bill Cubit.

A win on Saturday would give WMU only its third nine-win season in program history and first since the 2000 campaign.

Finally, a win would give the Broncos three straight over the Rockets, something that has not been accomplished since the 1976-78 seasons.

MOVERS AND SHAKERS • Western Michigan welcomed four new coaches to its staff prior to the 2008 season.

Mike Grant - Grant came to WMU after spending a season at Southern Miss and following nine season at Iowa State.

Rick Kravitz - Kravitz comes to WMU after spending a season as the defensive coordinator at Memphis. He brings 23 years of experience to Kalamazoo.

Mike Sabock - Sabock spent 24 seasons with MAC rival Northern Illinois under legendary head coach Joe Novak.

Ryan Cubit - Cubit, finishing graduate school, is in his first season with the Broncos as a member of the coaching staff, working with WMU's quarterbacks.
