## **Venue Specifications:**

## **Auditorium**

The auditorium is **wheelchair accessible**, with six wheelchair spaces. Seating area measures 66' (20.12m) deep by 46'6" (14.17m) wide. The centre bank accommodates 240 audience members in 20 rows. Each side bank seats 95 people in 19 rows. Total capacity is **430 seats** (plus the 6 wheelchair spaces).

## <u>Stage</u>

The stage is **proscenium style**, 30' (9.14m) high with hard surfaces at the sides and cloth teaser at the top. The **stage** sits at a height of 3'6" (1.07m), with stairs for audience access both sides. Floor is covered by black masonite, and is suitable for dance presentations. Framed by **three sets of black legs** each side, the stage is 35'5" (10.79m) wide at the proscenium opening, and 24' (7.32m) deep from apron to upstage edge. There is no front drape.

Upstage is a **movie screen** set 4'5" (1.34m) from stage floor. Dimensions of the screen are 11'4" (3.77m) high by 25'7" (7.80m) wide. The screen is suitable for **front screen projection or** for use as a **white cyclorama** for colored lights or gobo

projections. A maroon colored drape is available should the screen need to be covered. Projection throw is 103' (31.39m).

**Wing** usage is limited, as they must be kept clear as fire exits for patrons and performers. Props tables and small set pieces, or small operator positions can be hidden behind the legs. There is no backstage space, but through upstage doors left and right is access to a 2'6" (.76m) space behind the movie screen that can serve as a **crossover**.

Upstage right doors measuring 3'10 ½" (1.18m) wide lead to stairs down to a large **dressing room** suitable for a group. A bathroom with one toilet and sink are situated outside this room. Leading upstairs is a small dressing room suitable for one person, complete with its own toilet and sink. On this same level is an outside door leading to the alley.

Upstage left doors lead to a set of stairs and a landing with access to the electrics room. A door measuring  $3'10 \frac{1}{2}''$  (1.18m) wide leads to the alley. This alley access door is the usual **load in area**. It is at street level. A ramp is available to use from the street down the stairs to stage level.
