Notes:

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This election was the first with new boundaries and although we still have 55 seats these were in 26 wards (instead of 28). Because of the boundary changes, for this year only, every Maidstone Borough Council seat was up for election. Normally Maidstone Borough Council holds elections in thirds:

- One third of the seats on the borough council up for election at each election
- Elections held three years out of every four

A total of 139 candidates stood in the 26 wards - 45 Conservative, 42 Liberal Democrat, 29 Labour, 10 Green, 8 UK Independence and 5 Independent.
