Statement of Significance



Holy Trinity parish was organized in 1924, and this picturesque church was constructed two years later. A separate bell tower stands near the road. The church was consecrated in 1927 by the Most Reverend Theodorowich, Archbishop of the Ukrainian Greek Orthodox Church for the United States and Canada. The architectural design of this church reflects the Slavic origins of the parishioners, who came to this province during the early part of the 20th century. The building continues in use as a local church and stands as a landmark in the district. The Bell Tower was added to the existing church in 1926.
