

**Tours
of
Cape Canaveral Air Force Station
and
Air Force Space and Missile Museum**

1. 45th Space Wing - Public Affairs CCAFS Tour

Available to the general public (with some restrictions), no fee, reservations required.

Free historic bus tour for general public the second Wednesday of each month. The three-hour tour includes a visit to the Air Force Space and Missile Museum, active and retired launch pads and passes by the historic Cape Canaveral Lighthouse. The tour begins at 9:00 AM at the south gate of Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. Participants should meet directly across the street from the Pass & ID building no later than 8:45 AM. Reservations are required and seating is limited. Everyone must sign up by the Friday prior to the tour. Bus and most facilities are NOT handicap accessible. Tours are subject to cancellation due to mission requirements.

Requirements: No children under 12 years of age. No Foreign Nationals. Adults must be able to present two forms of official identification, such as a driver's license and passport, when boarding the bus.

Directions:

From the south and east - Travel north on A1A, exit right onto SR 401 ("A" Cruise Terminal exit), drive over Barge Canal drawbridge, past North Basin Cruise Terminals and past entrance/exit for North Port (two traffic lights).

Stay in the left lane. After passing through the chain link fence/gate, turn left into the parking lot directly across from the single-story Pass & ID building. *If you go through the THIRD traffic light and pass a red & white NAVAHO missile, you have gone too far!*

From the west and north - Travel east on SR 528 (Beachline - Bennett Causeway), exit right at SR 401, ("A" Cruise Terminal exit), drive over Barge

Canal drawbridge, past North Basin Cruise Terminals and past entrance/exit to North Port (two traffic lights).

Stay in the left lane. After passing through the chain link fence/gate, turn left into the parking lot directly across from the single-story Pass & ID building. *If you go through the THIRD traffic light and pass a red & white NAVAHO missile, you have gone too far!*

2. 45th Space Wing Services, Outdoor Recreation

Available to individuals with access to Patrick AFB, fee and reservations required.
