



eign School is an 11-18 Foundation comprehensive located in Kingsteignton, a large village to the north of Newton Abbot. The original 1936 buildings have grown substantially and we now have an eight form entry in Year 7 and a school of nearly 1200 students in Years 7-11 and 190 in Post 16. The school serves the communities of Kingsteignton, Chudleigh and the Teign Valley and we are very proud of our close working partnerships with other schools through the Teign Valley Learning Community.

We are proud of both our learning and results and the wide range of extra curricular activities our students and staff undertake. Over the years we have continuously developed our facilities

and as a Specialist Science School we have particularly focussed on the development of our Science and ICT facilities. We are also excited at the development of our Environmental and Land Based Studies course and the school farm unit, which will be operational from September 2008.




# Strong links with parents
