**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

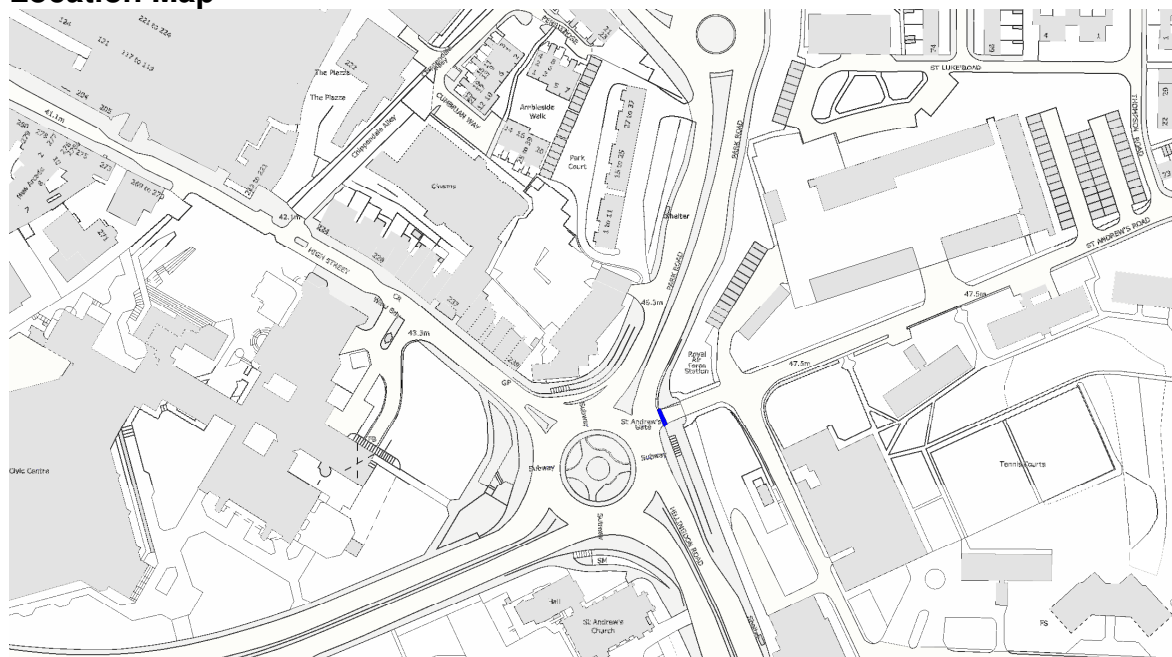
Architectural: Steel gates, displaying the Coat of Arms of the Borough of Uxbridge and the crest of RAF Uxbridge. The ends of the arch over pilasters also bear replicas of the Heraldic Tiger and Pegasus which are the supporters of the Borough of Uxbridge Coat of Arms.

Historical: Opened by the Mayor of Uxbridge, on 16<sup>th</sup> December 1957, celebrating 38 years and of the close ties between the town of Uxbridge and the RAF Station.
