



BIG BENN CHIMES IN TO DARTFORD!

Tony Benn is a prominent figure in British politics having won his first parliamentary seat in 1950 and served as Minister for Technology, Secretary of State for Industry and Secretary of State for Energy for the Labour Party before retiring in 2001. Benn served in World War II, appeared in Michael Moore's documentary Sicko, commenting on the NHS and boasts an appearance on Doctor Who. He will be appearing at The Orchard Theatre on September 14th presenting his show, 'An Evening with Tony Benn'. His latest book 'Letters to My Grandchildren' is released on 1st October, adding to an impressive collection of literary works released over the course of his career. Dartford Living's Abdel Khairoun catches up with him in Part 1 of his interview.

What can people expect from 'An Evening with Tony Benn'?

I talk about issues which concern people most: war, the economic crisis, democracy, religion. It's an open non-confrontational discussion with the audience about what we do about the biggest problems we face. People can ask questions but also give opinions - it's like a seminar!

What are your views on politics these days? Why is politics such a turn off for people?


The way politics is presented now is that you're expected to attack the other side and they're expected to attack you but why don't we just discuss with people with different opinions how you tackle the problem? It is possible to have a difference of opinion without having a punch up. You don't have to be an expert on every detail to ask why this problem isn't being tackled, or an expert on military strategy to ask why our boys are dying in Afghanistan. You can ask what's the war about? Why are we there? Are we succeeding? What else could we do? The media and political class underestimate people's intelligence but I believe people are far more intelligent then they're given credit for.

What about getting involved in local politics? Wouldn't that be a good start?

Well local government was completely strangled by Mrs Thatcher and it's not been liberated by New Labour. In the old days a local authority could do what it wanted if it could get local support. Now local authorities are only allowed to spend money the Treasury gives them on what the Treasury wants them to, so they've become local agents of the Treasury and are not democratically accountable to anybody. We talk about devolution to Scotland, what about local

Tell us your views on the Iraq war inquiry

The inquiry should be nothing other than an exploration of the truth in public. The questions it should answer should be why did we invade Iraa? Were we told the truth? When did Bush first decide to



invade Iraa? When did he tell Blair? And when did Blair garee that he

would support an invasion of Iraq? These questions don't involve any secret information at all and this report should answer all those questions and come out before the election so people can take into account what the inquiry has reported on but they've deliberately pushed it beyond the election. Government is responsible for explaining what it has done and I don't think we were told the truth.

Will we see a change of power at the next election? And what do you think of New Labour?

I'm not in the business of forecasting the future, my job is to try and influence the future. I've been a member of Labour for 70 odd years but never joined New Labour as Blair said it was a new political party. In effect it follows Mrs Thatcher's policies. She was asked her areatest achievement and she said New Labour!

Tell us more about your upcoming book, 'Letters to my Grandchildren'.

In the book I'm trying to deal with questions about the UN, Europe, nuclear power and more. At my age it's been rather interesting to ao over the problems and lessons I've learned and see whether it's relevant to their experience. I tell them that they're the first generation in human history that have it within their power to destroy the human race, but they're also the first generation in human history that have the technology and know-how, and if the money is spent wisely, to solve the problems of the human race. My generation made a complete muck of the world.





Consumer problems with holidays - Part 1

Advice to holidaymakers booking online

Please be careful when booking "do-it-yourself" holidays online. Due to the current economic conditions, most of us this summer will be tempted to surf the web and find cheap flights and accommodation and the majority of us will book our holiday online. However, before you do book your holiday online please ensure that you safeguard your interest. Ensure that the tour operator or travel company is a member of ATOL (Air Travel Organisers Licensing). That way, your holiday arrangements are protected.

The disadvantage of booking your flight and accommodation separately and not through a tour operator, means that this reduces the level of protection afforded to you. For example: if a consumer booked directly with an airline or hotel which then subsequently ceases to trade, that consumer may not receive a full refund and could find themselves stranded in a particular foreign country. If the consumer has a complaint about the quality of food, the cleanliness of the hotel or its represented facilities, the consumer will have to deal directly with the management.

One way of protecting yourself would be to always ensure that you take out travel insurance and pay at least the deposit by credit card when possible. Provided the cost is over £100, by using a credit card, the credit card company will normally be jointly liable in the event of any breach of contract.

There are no special ways of making a complaint against the holiday bought online. Try to get the supplier to put things right first and if that doesn't work then contact any trade association which the supplier belongs to. If you are still unhappy you can consider taking Court action in the small claims Court for amounts not more than £2,000 and for larger amounts speak to a solicitor.

Holidays do not always go as planned and holidaymakers do suffer unfortunate accidents. Tour operators are under a duty to ensure that their customers' accommodation is both safe and hygienic and that customers are not exposed to the risk of


injury, disease or infection. When in an unfamiliar country you may not be able to seek immediate legal advice, but you can as soon as you arrive home.

Ten things to remember if you have an accident abroad

- Take photographs of either the defect or cause of the accident;
- Take photographs of the injury suffered;
- Ensure that the accident is reported to the tour operator and if necessary the hotel;
- Keep a copy of the Accident Report Form;
- Ensure that you note down names and addresses of witnesses;
- Seek immediate medical treatment if required;
- Make a note of the name and address of the hospital attended and the names of any doctors who treated you;
- If a travel insurance policy was taken out, inform the insurance company immediately of the accident, even if you cant do this until you get home;
- Seek legal advice as soon as you get home because the time limits in which you must make a claim differ from country to country:
- Don't throw away your travel documentation

This month's article looks at the manufacturers more economical versions of the latest cars, as they attempt to reduce their carbon footprints.

Audi A3 69mpg – Audi has launched its most economical car ever: an A3 with an economical new diesel engine. The new A3 1.6 TDI hatchback emits 109g/km of carbon dioxide while



averaging 68.9mpg. This engine will also be offered on the A3 Cabriolet. The fuel saving comes from Audi's decision to fit stop/start as standard, which cuts CO2 emissions by up to 5g/km alone. Prices kick off at £17,485 for the new 1.6 TDI, while an A3 Cabriolet with the same engine starts at £20,645.

Volkswagen Polo

 Volkswagen has announced prices for its fifth-generation Polo, now available to order in advance of its on-sale date of 16th October 2009. Prices



for the new supermini range from £10,035 for the 1.2 litre fivedoor to £14,910 for the 1.6 litre diesel. A three-door model will be available in December. At launch there'll be a choice of five engines: three petrol and two diesels. The petrols are the 1.2 litre engines with 58bhp or 68bhp and a 1.4 litre 83bhp. The 1.6litre TDI units offered in the Polo come in 73bhp or 88bhp power outputs. A turbocharged engine is expected in early 2010.

Nissan Leaf – Nissan has unveiled a new all-electric small family hatchback called the Leaf. At £20,000 Nissan believe the Leaf will be the world's first 'affordable' electric car when it goes on sale in the UK in 2011. The Leaf boasts a real-world range of more than 100 miles and under the bonnet there's a 108bhp electric motor that propels the

Leaf from 0-62mph in less than 10 seconds and then on to a top speed of 90mph. It can be charged up to 80% of its full capacity in just 30 minutes with a quick charger.





Gardening Tips for September...

Ideas for your garden in September

Flowers

- Clear away faded summer bedding plants and plant out Pansies, Wallflowers and other spring bedding plants
- Sow hardy annuals outside to flower for next spring
- Deadhead Roses regularly
- Spray Roses to control black spot mildew and aphids
- Water Camellias regularly as they are now forming next year's flower buds
- Dead head annuals, perennials and Roses
- Continue spraying for mildew and other fungal diseases
- Towards the end of the month prepare to move evergreens and perennials that are growing in the wrong places
- Clear up any fallen leaves and other dead plant material to prevent diseases over wintering and remove shelter for vine Weevils

'egetables

- Lift onions and dry them before storing them
- Harvest plants as soon as they are ready to get maximum flavour from them
- Cut and dry herbs for use in the winter
- Continue to take precautions against slugs and snails
- Regular hoeing will keep weeds down and prevent seeds being dropped on to the soil to create problems for the following year

Lawn

- Now is a good time to sow new lawns using either seed or turf
- Use autumn lawn-care products
- After the summer lawns often need a bit of pampering and September is the traditional month to do this.

- Start by removing unwanted weeds.
- Most lawns, depending on the soil type, also benefit from being aerated every year. Do this by making holes in the soil with a garden fork and then rake in a bit of autumn lawn feed. This is not as necessary with sandy free draining soils.
- Bad muddy patches should be re-turfed.

General Tasks

- Top canes with cane-caps to protect eyes
- Clean paving or slabs with an alaicide
- Use a Residual Current Device (RCD) when using any electrical equipment in the garden
- Feed the garden using a granular fertiliser like Growmore or Rose Plus
