
METHODOLOGY

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of 1,210 Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between August 29th and September 1st, 2011. The statistics of a random sample of 1,210 respondents are accurate to within 2.8 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. For 939 committed voters, it is accurate to within 3.2 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20.

Results for 2011–08 are from a random telephone survey of 1,203 Canadians conducted between July 25th and August 2nd, 2011.

Any use of this research data should identify it as a "CTV/Globe/Nanos Poll".


