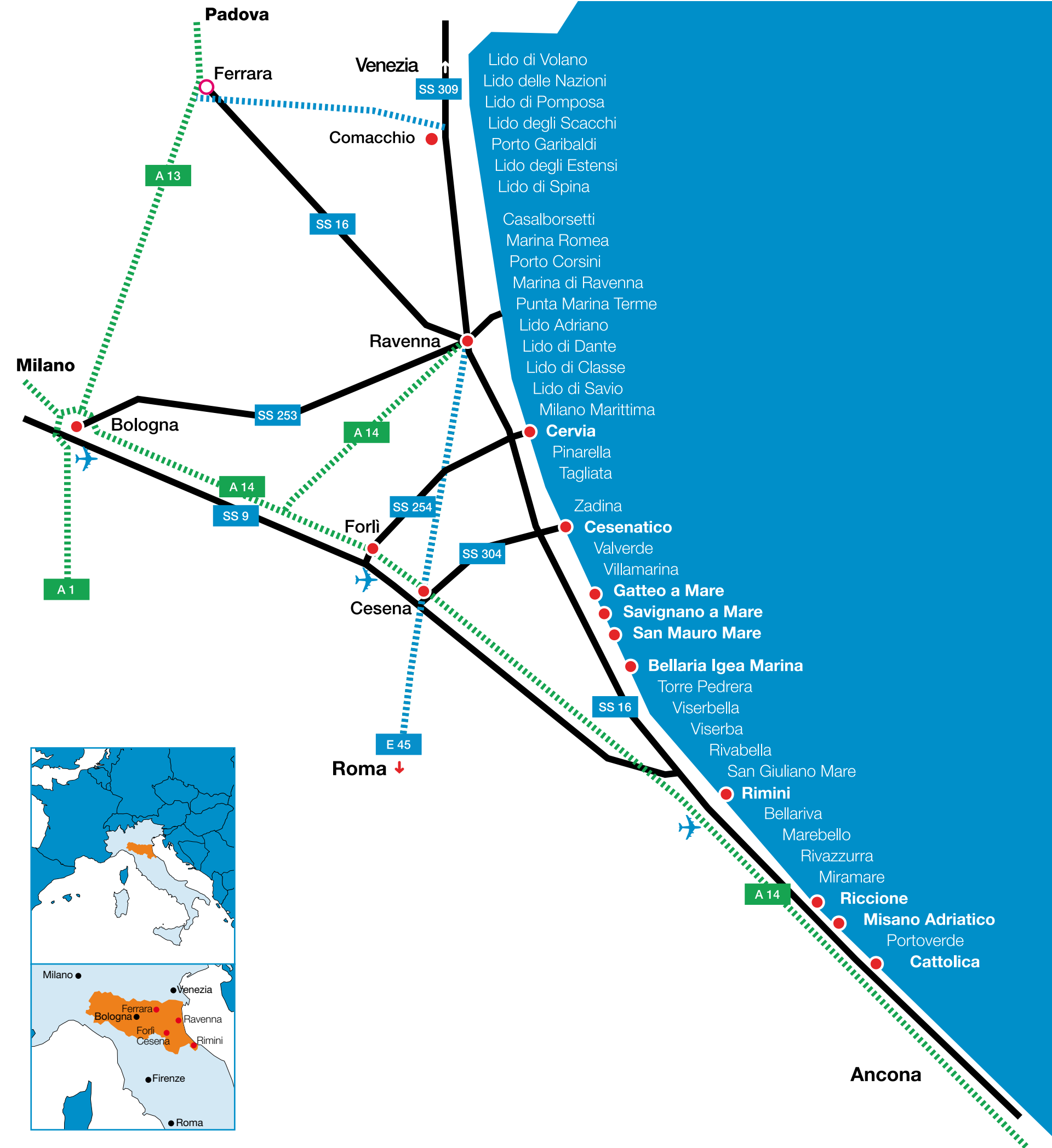

Lidi di Comacchio

The Park beaches

Seaside holidaymaking tied to the environment, where each locality has its own charm: pristine, for families, fashionable.



Not to be missed

Typical Comacchio

Typical Comacchio specialities, where eels play a leading role, accompanied by the wines of Bosco Eliceo. Not to mention other delicious items such as clams, mussels, sea-bass, gilthead and mullet.

The trails

The trails that criss-cross the Po Delta Park amid dry land and water, and which can be covered on foot, by bike or on horseback, pass through areas of great scenic beauty – creeks, salt pans and pinewoods.

Museum

Well worth a visit is the old-town centre of Comacchio – the Roman Ship Museum, with artefacts dating back to the 1st century B.C., the 18th-century Ospedale degli Infermi, site of historical-archaeological exhibitions, and the elegant Palazzo Bellini, which houses the Civic Library and Historical Archive, not forgetting Manifattura dei Marinati, the factory where Comacchio marinated eel is still processed today.

Entertainment

In Comacchio, the nights are animated by historical regattas on the canals, street dancing and theatre, seafaring sounds and tales, fashion parades, popular festivals and firework displays. The monumental Trepponti bridge is the heart of these activities.

A holiday in the seven Lidos of Comacchio is “special”. Accommodation along this 23 km of coast mainly involves apartments (25 thousand) and camp sites. There are “only” 35 hotels. Many visitors are interested in the surrounding countryside and come to see the natural environment of the Po Delta Park, directly behind the wide beaches. From north to south, each Lido has its own specific identity.

Lido di Volano is the “wildest”, Lido delle Nazioni offers a mix of Delta breed horses and spa facilities (seasonal, with water dating back 5 thousand years), the Lido degli Scacchi and Pomposa are ideal for families. Here we find Porto Garibaldi with its large fishing harbour and marina (mooring space for 300 boats) and its “history”, Lido degli Estensi is the “lounge” and Lido di Spina, the last and southernmost locality, is renowned for its pinewood and the Museum home of Remo Brindisi.

At the Lidos of Comacchio (Blue Flags for various consecutive years), the large equipped beaches stand side by side with stretches of pristine sand, while the various localities provide top-quality amenities with plenty to do for the kids and strong focus on entertainment and security. On Sundays, in July and August, the local life-saving service recruits trained dogs to lend a hand. During the week, each Lido holds a shopping market, with lots of side events and entertainment. Night-life abounds and during the late and early hours buses link the various discos and venues.

Local cuisine is keyed to Delta traditions and for those who want to keep in shape after eating a plate of fish and drinking a glass of wine, there is a broad choice of sports equipment on the beaches. Alternatively, a bike ride is ideal for making contact with the natural environment.

The trendy coast

Nine beaches for lots of different ways of approaching a holiday along the Adriatic Coast. This is what the Ravenna coast, between Casalborgorsetti and Lido di Savio, has to offer. Casalborgorsetti, in the past a small fishing village, is now at the centre of major changes, starting with the new marina, able to accommodate 400 boats and plans to build a new golf course.

Just a few kilometres away is Marina Romea: wide beach, excellent hotels and close ties with the creeks and pinewoods of the nearby Po Delta park. Another small village is Porto Corsini, a departure point for horse rides through the hinterland.

For some years now, Marina di Ravenna has been one of the coast's trendiest localities, especially since the beach has been made accessible in the evening, with music, restaurants, films and the presentation of books. The town boasts the largest marina on the Adriatic coast, Marinara, with mooring space for 1100 boats. The main road, lined with pine trees, leads to Punta Marina, or Punta Marina Terme as it is now called. Here visitors will find a spa centre on the beach which exploits all the beneficial properties of the salty, bromine and iodine water.

A broad range of accommodation (hotels and apartments) is available at Lido Adriano, a big favourite with families. Nudism and nature coexist at Lido di Dante, one of the Italian beaches open to nudists, just a few hundred metres from the mouth of the Bevano river, with its pristine natural environment of sand dunes. Finally, the last two Lidos, both very similar the one to the other: Lido di Classe and Lido di Savio which, besides the sea and pinewood, also offer holiday packages that include the nearby Mirabilandia amusement park.

Not to be missed

The mosaics

The ancient mosaics, which make Ravenna the capital of mosaic art - eight of its monuments have been declared "World Heritage" sites by UNESCO. During the summer months, evening guided visits to the Basilica of San Vitale, to the Mausoleum of Galla Placidia, to the Domus of the Stone Carpets and to the San Nicolò complex.

Ravenna Festival

The prestigious Ravenna Festival, with its outstanding concerts, stage performances and operas.

Bassona beach

Taking a dip at Bassona, which Legambiente (Society for the Protection of the Environment) has included among the ten most beautiful beaches in Italy. Surrounded by the Lido di Dante nature reserve at the River Bevano delta, the beach - a part of which is set aside for nudists - lies next to a large pinewood and a series of sand dunes that stretch for over one kilometre.

Excursions

An underwater visit off Marina di Ravenna to the Paguro reserve, the wreck of a platform with its thriving marine vegetation that has become a natural habitat for fish and shellfish.

Cervia Milano Marittima

Naturally elegant

Environment, gastronomy, fashion and superior hotels - different ways of being on holiday.



Tradition and modernity, traces of the ancient salt civilisation and elegant and sophisticated site amenities, atmospheres of times gone by and a “worldly air” coexist side by side at Cervia Milano Marittima. Two different, but complementary “hearts” for a locality that has earned itself a place of honour among European holiday capitals.

On the one side is Milano Marittima (established in 1912 by a group of Milanese industrialists), with its fashion boutiques, crowded night clubs, modern hotels, well-attended roundabouts, gardens and greenery, a 27-hole golf club, the celebrities who attend the trendiest clubs, the beach parties and “full optional” bathing establishments and the luxuriant pinewood, the ideal place for jogging or relaxing walks.

On the other side is Cervia, with its salt-pans, the salt-pan workers’ village, the fishing nets on board the fishing boats in the Canal Harbour, Piazza Garibaldi with its beautiful paving stones, the spa, the plates of fish cooked in the traditional way in the many restaurants, the industrial architecture of the Salt Stores and the San Michele Tower and numerous events, from the World Kiting Festival to the Sand Castle Master.

All the holidaymaker has to do is choose and it only takes a short walk to move from one world to another – from an aperitif at Milano Marittima to the history and culture of Cervia evoked by the “quadrilateral” of the Saltpan workers’ village (the old-town centre) and the Salt Museum housed in the “Magazzen” (Stores) where the “white gold” was kept.

House of Butterflies

Green and blue are the characteristic colours of Cervia, a town where flower-filled gardens give off inebriating perfumes. More colour is provided by the butterflies at Casa delle Farfalle & Co (House of Butterflies) with 1200 square metres of exotic environment for beautiful Amazonian, African and Indo-Australian butterflies and characteristic habitat for the insects that show off all their particular features.

Wellness

The Spa Centres, the beach and the hotels offer wellness areas for both physical and psychological health, with massages, whirlpool baths and wellness treatment sessions, also with the possibility for customised treatment sessions.

Excursions

Excursions in the green areas of the salt pans and pinewoods enable direct contact with nature but also with music, thanks to the summer concerts.

New

The brand new CerviAvventura, the park where you can experience the thrill of flight amidst the pines.

Cesenatico

A seafaring town

“Bragozzi” and “battane”, fish restaurants and shopping in the splendid setting of the canal harbour.

Top-class fish restaurants inserted in a truly unique setting – a harbour designed five centuries ago by Leonardo da Vinci. Cesenatico is a town that maintains a precise seafaring identity. Moored in the upper part of the canal harbour are the bragozzi, battane and trabaccoli ships of the Seafaring Museum together with a splendid “dry” section, while behind the wharfs stand the “Conserve”, enormous conical-shaped containers, once used as “refrigerators” to store the fresh fish, which was covered with pressed snow and ice.

Not to be missed

Museum

A visit to the Museo della Marineria, which witnesses the city's seafaring soul, with its outdoor exhibition of ancient armed boats with brightly coloured sails “vele al terzo” the only one of its kind in Italy.

Fishing-oriented tourism

Try the fascinating experience of fishing-oriented tourism accompanied by the sector's direct protagonists, the fishermen, who readily disclose their professional secrets and methods and then savour our traditional fish-based recipes at the gourmet events “Azzurro come il pesce” (As blue as a fish) in spring and “Il pesce fa festa” (Fish celebrations) in autumn.

“Spazio Pantani”

Relive the great sporting achievements of the cycling champion from Romagna, Marco Pantani, in the Spazio Pantani, riding your bike along the hinterland itineraries on which Marco used to train, perhaps in preparation for the Nove Colli, Europe's most popular bike race, with over 10,000 participants.

Garibaldi Festival

Take part on one of the summer events awaited by locals and tourists alike: the Garibaldi Festival, celebrated on the first weekend of August and evoking the historical episode of the hero's embarkation at the port of Cesenatico, with official ceremonies, the traditional Palio della Cuccagna and finally a magnificent firework display.

Cesenatico is also famous for its gourmet restaurants: every year over half a million people from all over Italy and Europe enjoy the culinary delights the town has to offer.

Cesenatico is a European holiday capital. Besides the beach, it also organises numerous sporting events – the Nove Colli long-distance cycle race, the “Vele di Pasqua” race for catamarans, staged at Easter, numerous beach volleyball courts located here and there among the golden sands of the bathing establishments, the marina, two large green parks to the north and south, a golf course and sailing schools.

Cycling enthusiasts, and other too, will not fail to visit Spazio Pantani, a 300 sq.mt. exhibition area where photos, family heirlooms and audiovisual material belonging to the Champion of Cesenatico reconstruct the pirate's career. A town with an enviable lifestyle: over 40 km of tree-lined streets with splendid hotels, villas, shops and restaurants.

Many celebrities live here: Alberto Zaccheroni, Azeglio Vicini, Dario Fo. On the left bank of the canal harbour is the home of famous 20th-century writer Marino Moretti. This is open to the public and contains manuscripts and documents of all kinds.

One of Cesenatico's most charming events is staged in the winter, when the Seafaring Crèche is set up on the old boats moored in the harbour: on this occasion, the place of the ox and ass is taken by dolphins and the gifts presented to the Child Jesus are fish and piadina.

Gatteo a Mare

Would you like to dance?

In the home-town of the Casadei family, a holiday for children and adults alike.



"Would you like to dance?" This is the most frequently asked question at Gatteo Mare. Of course, you are free to accept or not, but remember that this small seaside resort (7,000 inhabitants) is considered the place where "liscio" dancing was born.

"Romagna Mia", at the top of the charts for being the most played, sung and danced melody in the world, saw the light here along with the famous Casadei dynasty. And if you don't know how to dance, never mind, you'll learn. Dance halls are not lacking for sure in this part of the land. Polka and mazurka are even danced at dawn: the most curious appointment is on the beach at Gatteo every morning from 6 to 8.30.

The town is distinguished by a cheerful atmosphere, but above all it is highly organised. You can be sure that people will do all they can to give you a great holiday. Within its one square kilometre of surface area, the town boasts 90 hotels, 30 bathing establishments, bike and pedal-boat rental, tennis, miniature golf, swimming-pools, water-skiing, one hundred shops and craft workshops. The most original? The artistically-made bread shops, real works of art that have even been made to order for pope John Paul II.

This peaceful haven is very popular with families with children. Besides the sea and beach however, Gatteo has a history stretching far back through the centuries. It was originally a Roman settlement (many archaeological artefacts have been discovered) and Julius Caesar's historical Rubicone river runs through it. Not to be missed: the turreted medieval Castle with a moat where, on 10 August, the feast of the patron saint St. Laurence is held, and the beautiful San Rocco Oratory.

Julius Caesar

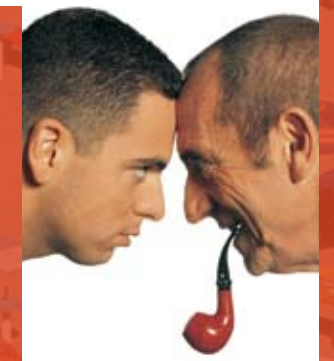
"Alea iacta est", the dice is cast, are the famous words pronounced by Julius Caesar on crossing the River Rubicone. Now the river can be crossed by the new cyclist/pedestrian bridge linking Gatteo a Mare to Savignano and San Mauro Mare, where a bronze bust of Julius Caesar can be admired.

Summer events

The town offers visitors a series of unique summer events: the "Settimana della Micizia" (Friendship with Cats Week) in July; the musical review "Siola d'Oro" dedicated to the memory of the famous soprano Lina Pagliughi, whose birth centenary is celebrated this year; and, "Gatteo in Musica" with its extensive choice of summer concerts.

Savignano Mare

A 180 metre oasis

The shortest beach of the Adriatic Coast of Emilia Romagna is just 180 metres long. Welcome to Savignano Mare, a gem of fine sand that shines just a few hundred metres from the right bank of the mouth of the Rubicone river. A protected area full of charm that represents the singular short coastline of the Municipality of Savignano sul Rubicone.

Here, the big amenity for visitors is the award-winning 5-star campsite with lots of activities on offer (from golf to sailing) and where children can have the time of their lives in the swimming pools, on the slides, with inflatable games, entertainment, in a real paradise for kids.

If you lift your gaze towards the sky, you can see 12 different types of seagulls. Behind the beach in fact is a protected area that extends over two hectares, chosen by the Lipu (Italian Association for the Protection of Birds) for its new "Coastal oasis". This nature park stretches along 12 km of coast (including parts of Cesenatico, Gatteo and San Mauro) and is the perfect place for birdwatching or nature walks. The entrance to the park is from the former S.S. 16 main road with a car park and information desk.

Talking about walks, do not miss that across the spectacular wooden bridge that stretches across the Rubicone river mouth. The walk starts in San Mauro Mare and ends in Gatteo. Walking over the bridge is like being suspended in the air while below, boats enter and leave the marina. The most photographed point of the bridge? Naturally that with the bronze bust of Julius Caesar with the legendary words "alea iacta est", the dice is cast.

Festival

Only a few kilometres from the sea, Savignano sul Rubicone is the centre of permanent activity in the photography, image and visual communications field. One of the cult events held in September is "SI FEST Savignano Immagini Festival", a festival of photography and videos, exhibitions, meetings, readings and projections which is a major appointment for critics, enthusiasts and artists from Italy and abroad.

History

The Roman bridge on the historical river Rubicone, a river that defined Ancient Rome's northern border.

Museum

The Ancient Pieve Romanica (Romanesque Parish Church) of San Giovanni in Compito, which dates back to the 11th century, with the adjacent small but significant Museo Archeologico del Compito, displaying major Roman and medieval artefacts. The prestigious Accademia dei Filopatridi, founded in the 17th century, which houses a vast assortment of documents dating from the 12th century to the present day.

What is a family's holiday dream? It is perfect relaxation. This is the challenge faced by San Mauro Mare, a little town along the Romagna coastline, midway between Rimini and Cesenatico. It offers a clean sea with a shallow seabed, protected play areas on the beach and fully equipped green parks where visitors may rest during the warmest hours of the day, besides organized entertainment for both kids and adults on the beach and on pleasant summer evenings. This is the business card of a resort focused on tailor-made holidays for children.

The family beach has in fact a calm sea caressed by the memories of generations that made it a privileged holiday target. It was the beach for holidays with grandparents, peaceful days with parents and today a place to be enjoyed with ones own children.

The ideal way to spend a day is clearly to enjoy the beach, the sea and “on the beach” initiatives. And yet, we suggest that visitors should find the time to discover the rest too. San Mauro is a place of culture: it is the land of Giovanni Pascoli; the house where the poet was born has been a national monument since 1924; it is the landscape mirrored in the eyes of the cavallina storna, protagonist of Pascoli's famous poem, which also relates about the “Torre”, the magnificent estate formerly owned by the earls of Torlonia.

Summer evenings witness the courtyard charged with the suggestive atmosphere of the “Giardino della Poesia” (Garden of Poetry), of celebrations in the barnyard, of concerts and dramas.

And if you long to discover spots hidden away in the hinterland, you can participate in free excursions with food and wine sampling organised by the Municipality.

A short stroll will immerse you in the vegetation, colours and peaceful atmosphere of Isola dei Platani, the city's pulsating heart where tourists and residents alike meet either on a glamorous shopping spree or to sip an aperitif in one of the many bars, which enliven the area.

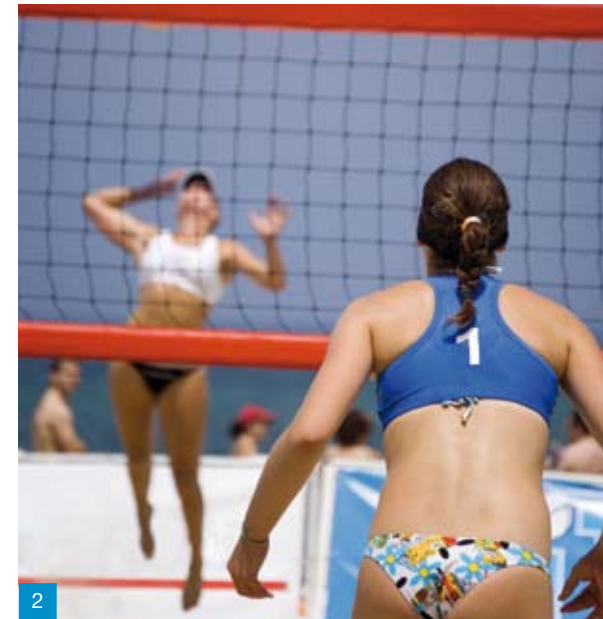
The historical centre's natural surroundings play the absolute and unquestioned protagonist with both trekking paths and cycle lanes, which run amidst century-old oak, pine and durmast oak trees that rise throughout the Uso river's nature park. Then we find a lake in Parco del Gelso (Mulberry Park) and the 2 km. stretch of white sandy beach along the southern border of Igea Marina – the largest and one of the most beautiful free beaches along the entire Adriatic Coast.

A beach with a dual life and a dual soul: in the day an open air gym for all types of activities ranging from beach volley played on the entire sandy shore to yoga and fitness programmes organised in the Polo Est village area, sailing centres, a sailing school and beach golf, at night shows and music rule the scene till dawn in the new Beky Bay facility, which is a free meeting area.

Concerts, shows, cabaret, music and theatre events, historical commemorations such as "Lo sbarco dei Saraceni" (The Landing of the Saracens) liven up summer evenings. The BellariaFilmFestival-Antepremadoc and "Junior" Quality Filmmaking Preview, which numbers shows for children, is worth mentioning, besides the extensive choice of sports with national Beach Volley competitions involving matches on the beach from April onwards.

Entertainment

A new area for music and entertainment at night: Beky Bay. Igea Marina's current meeting spot is directly on the beach: stage, dance floor and catering stalls welcome both tourists and protagonists of the musical and showbiz scene.

Casa Panzini

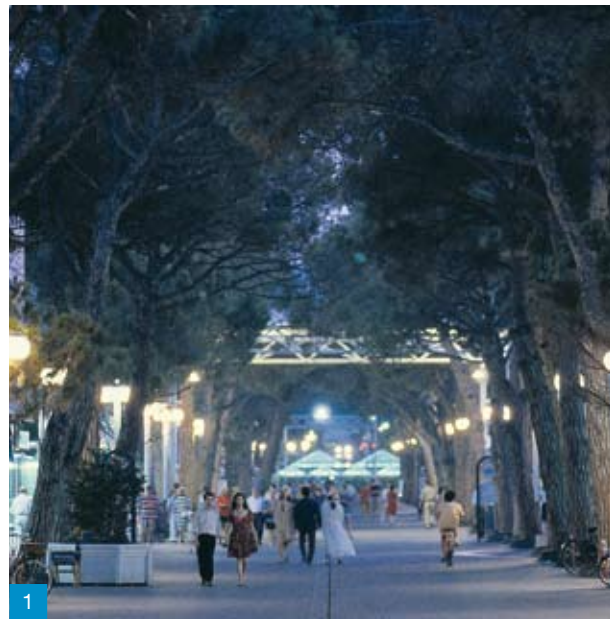

Perfect for children and reassuring for mums. But above all... creative for everyone. The Emilia Romagna sea, the blue outline to 110 kilometres of coast, can be enjoyed to the full 24 hours a day. The sea is the ideal habitat for dancing, sports activities (sailing, surfing, wind surfing, kite surfing and water skiing), walking, talking, trips out on a pedalò, playing beach volley and beach tennis, activities with the children, snorkelling and now even relaxing, with offshore meditation and yoga on yachts. Obviously you can swim too, if you like!

The perfect lounge, and not just because the bed of this fortunate area of the Adriatic is very shallow for metres and metres out from the beach, offering

the chance to enjoy so many activities, but, above all, because this mirror of water in front of the Emilia Romagna coast is one of the cleanest in Europe.

An increasing number of blue flags flutter over the various towns and strict tests run by the German Automobile Club have concluded that Emilia Romagna has the healthiest sea in the whole Mediterranean area: out of 91 sampling areas, 87 were awarded top marks.

So the water is safe. This could also be due to the fact that there are over 800 lifeguards –one every 150 metres – watching over the safety of bathers. It should also be noted that there are 45 first aid cen-

La Daphne

The water of Emilia-Romagna is probably the closest monitored, inspected and controlled in the world. Every week, all year round, the laboratory boat of the Daphne, i.e.: the oceanography structure of Emilia Romagna (now transferred to the Regional ARPA) runs tests to analyse practically everything: how much phosphor, how much nitrogen, how much dissolved oxygen, how much chlorophyll, how much and what kind of

zooplankton, what kind of fauna is present in the water at that moment, from Lido di Volano to Cattolica.

The aim? To know, in real time, the state of the sea's health. The bulletin of the results is available to anyone on the Internet. The address is www.arpa.emr.it/daphne.

The task force of biologists who look after the Emilia-Romagna

sea is based in Viale Vespucci 2, not far from the pretty port of Cesenatico designed by Leonardo da Vinci. It is from here that, every week, at seven o'clock in the morning, the engines of the laboratory boat of Daphne 2 start up.

"The measurements have become more and more sophisticated", explains biologist and researcher Attilio Rinaldi, the operational manager.

"Today we use marine cameras linked up to satellites to inspect the seabed".

Nature's wonders

Amidst land and sea, piles of salt, eels and flamingos.



"It's early morning. I wait for the mist to lift and admire the view: ducks, herons, teals and coots. Surrounded by water and silence". These aren't the words of Lord Byron and not even those of an advertising company with the latest product to promote. They're simply an expression of the feelings aroused by the natural environment that runs along the coast from Ferrara to Cattolica. A territory capable of allowing the coexistence of a huge range of seaside facilities with an unspoilt natural heritage.

We suggest you take a trip to discover it: marshlands, pinewoods, natural dunes, salt pans, hills, parish churches, gullies, flora and fauna. A route which comprises the Po Delta Park, with

Bosco della Mesola, the Sacca di Goro immediately inland, the Comacchio lagoons and marshlands (remember Giuseppe Garibaldi with Anita dying in his arms as he flees into the mist...), Ravenna's tidal lagoons, the mouth of the Apennine rivers such as the Reno, the Lamone, the Bevano, the Fiumi Uniti and then the Salt pans of Cervia. A real mixture of nature and gastronomy. This isn't just a list of the environmental beauties to be observed, but also an unspoilt excerpt of Italian history, which tourists would be wise not to miss (www.parcodeltapo.it).

Further south and further into the inland areas of Rimini, the Marecchia Valley and the Oriented Nature Reserve of Onferno offer a glimpse of rural an-

the "Paguro", an off-shore rig which exploded in 1965 and which, thirty years later, has developed into a "biologically protected area". After contacting the Paguro Association (0544 531 140) you can dive down

below to discover fauna and flora which cannot be found anywhere else in the Adriatic.

The wreck - the highest part of which sits 12/15 metres below sea level - offers a home to croakers, sea bream, lobsters, sea bass and saddled bream.

tiquity. The caves, gullies, stone dwellings, bats and an extraordinary range of fauna lead to the Naturalistic Museum at the visitors' centre (www.emilia.romagna.it/parchi/onferno).

Well inland, miles from the coast, the Apennines show us a new dimension of nature: that of deer and wild boar, parish churches and fortresses. And those who hanker after "greenness" and tranquility can head for the hills above Forlì, Cesena or Faenza and gaze out over the vineyards or wheat fields, where a pheasant in flight can always be seen (www.parcforestecasentinesi.it).

The beach bars (especially at Marina di Ravenna and Riccione) “cast off” their daywear and are transformed into seashore clubs while the slow “migration” towards the dance temples, the dance halls where “liscio” ballroom dancing reigns and the discos where the DJs play the latest offerings in terms of house, techno and dance music begins.

The Terme di Punta Marina (0544 437 222), situated between the sea and Pinewood at Ravenna, propose not only innovative treatments for skin renewal but also take advantage of the thermal water with a high magnesium content.

The Thermae Oasis at Lido delle Nazioni (0533 399 706) meet every health-related need with the fully equipped Care Centre, catering for "wellness" with the Giardini del Benessere: soak in the thermal baths, stretch out in a steam cave or recharge your batteries with a hot stone massage.

In addition to the traditional spa treatments, they offer the latest in cosmetic medicine and well-being, with short or week-long programmes, investing in quality of service and reception facilities, the professional skills of the operators and constant renewal to meet every need. Choose between a weekend devoted exclusively to

relaxation or a short holiday dedicated to getting back into shape, with therapeutic or beauty treatments and a natural diet.

The region's spas have added value too: they are the only ones with Emilia Romagna all around, a land which, besides having a considerably beautiful landscape and immense cultural and wine-gastronomy riches, makes hospitality one of its leading characteristics.

Entrusted into expert hands, the coastline spas offer thermal pools, massages with essential oils, underwater massages, watercourses, treatments with mother waters and mud, thalassotherapy, thermal

The Adriatic Coast never stands still.



Have fun while you fill up on energy: that's what the Adriatic Coast of Emilia Romagna gives you, the chance to do if you want, to spend an active holiday at the seaside or inland. Along the 110 Km of coast that stretch from Lidi di Comacchio to Cattolica, alongside traditional beach sports, the 1,430 beach establishments, which become outdoor gyms, offer lots of original opportunities for physical activity: from free climbing to kite surfing, from golf to capoeira, the Brazilian combat-dancing technique. For those who prefer to move while they relax, the coast also offers aerobics and yoga lessons.

There are 13 tourist harbours with 5200 moorings and from April to September, yacht clubs offer

lessons on how to manage a boat, catamaran or surfboard. For those who prefer bikes to waves, the coast is as varied as ever and offers interesting itineraries for cycling enthusiasts with made to measure services in many hotels.

National and international events also take place on the coast. Misano Adriatico is home to races for the Moto GP, World Superbike and Motorbike Championships and Cesenatico hosts the "Nove Colli" cycling event which attracts thousands of participants from all over Europe.

Rimini hosts the Rimini Wellness, the Paganello World Frisbee Championship and BluRimini, the

Delights for the palate

It would be a real shame to start your diet right now, in Romagna.

If you think the food's good in Emilia Romagna, wait till you taste the wine

The famous Romagna hills, wonderful balconies over the sea, produce various kind of DOC wines and even a DOCG: the famous Albana di Romagna.

During your holiday you will have the chance to taste Colli di Rimini, Vini di Romagna, Colli di Faenza and Bosco Eliceo.

Among the red wines, the most popular ones include Sangiovese, with its delicate

fragrance reminiscent of pansies, Cagnina with its sweet flavour, lively Fortana with its dry or semi-sweet flavour, and Merlot with its slightly herbaceous scent and dry, harmonious aroma.

Among the most famous white wines, in addition to the fruity Albana di Romagna, semi-sweet or dry, the table is graced by Trebbiano, perfect with light flavoured fish or meat dishes, Pagadebit with its characteristic

fragrance of hawthorn, dry, semi-sweet, or even sparkling is wonderful when served for example with a piadina with salami.

Among the DOC wines of Colli di Rimini there is also Biancame, dry, fresh and well balanced, served with shellfish and fish entrées, and Rebola (dry, semi-sweet and passito) with a fruity aroma: serve it with flavoured or blue cheeses (in the passito

version), with fruit tarts and cakes (semi-sweet) and with Adriatic mackerel in the dry version.



Amidst piadina kiosks, open day and night, characterised by the most irresistible fragrance (hands up those who can refuse a steaming piadina!), typical cheeses you simply can't find anywhere else, such as squacquerone, raviggiolo or formaggio di fossa, the freshest fish, caught every day, hand-rolled pasta and excellent wines, pausing to eat is one of the most sublime moments during a holiday on the coast.

But the best thing (which you won't fail to notice) is that for the locals, sitting around a table is a way of spending time together. If possible, for having a party too: all they need is an accordion and they all get up and start waltzing around.

The leading feature of any meal has to be fish, the "pesce azzurro" (mackerel, anchoives) caught off the 110 km of coast and baby squid, cuttlefish, sole, prawns, crayfish, monkfish, sardines and clams. Cooked in a variety of ways: from the typical barbecued fish "rustida", to the steaming seafood stew "brodetto" or golden mixed fry. In the north, at the Lidi di Comacchio the traditional marinated eel is protected and promoted by Slow Food.

Equally particular is the "acquadella" (silver fish), a small fish prepared at the end of the year and conserved in glass jars. At the lidos of Ravenna you simply must try sea bass cooked covered with the "sweet salt" of Cervia or "naked men", tiny little fish

coated in flour and fried. And naturally everything is served with a drizzle of the finest extra virgin olive oil. Such as the DOP oil of Brisighella or the DOP of Colline di Romagna.

While we're on the subject of fish, in Cesenatico the fishing tradition is highlighted by the old "conserva", a sort of well which was filled with ice to store the day's catch, which can still be seen in one of the prettiest squares.

The prestigious products which have been awarded the European quality mark, in addition to the aforementioned Extra virgin olive oil of Brisighella Dop and Colline di Romagna Dop, include the Peach and Nectarine of Romagna Igp (taste these peaches and you'll be amazed at the difference!), the Scallion of Romagna Igp, the Pear of Emilia Romagna Igp, the typical bread of Ferrara and Lidi di Comacchio, i.e.: Coppia Ferrarese Igp, and also the Rimini piadina and the Romagna piadina, which are currently awaiting the quality mark.

A curiosity related to Romagna cuisine regards "Savor", a sort of thick, dark chutney served with sweets dishes, roasts and boiled meats. It is similar to another sauce, "Saba", made of grape must and served with flavoured cheeses, vegetables, beans and fried sweets.

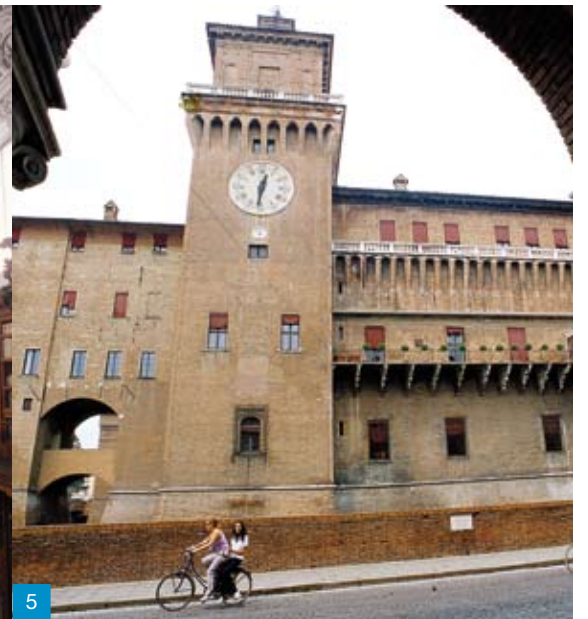
Events, art and culture

My dad would love to go and see the Miss Wet T-shirt competition, but he'd never tell you. Bearing in mind that he sweats in the gym all year round, he'd also like to take part in the "Nove colli" cycling race which starts from Cesenatico.

My mum would like to see the "Sposalizio del mare" which has been celebrated in Cervia for nearly 600 years and perhaps even the mosaics at San Vitale, because she knows her son is quite likely to see them in art books at school.

And what about the kids? Huge beaches, lots to do at San Mauro Mare in the gazebos set up on the beach and lots of sport, or a weekend in Rimini

when it is transformed into the Frisbee capital with the Paganello World Championship. This is the entertainment offered by the Adriatic Coast: there's everything and a little bit more for everyone.

It's incredible how Romagna's businessmen manage to combine the history of the Castello Estense and the Palazzo dei Diamanti in Ferrara with the Fashion shows of Trepponti di Comacchio and the Buskers Festival in Ferrara. Not forgetting the splendour of Sant'Apollinare in Classe, a dinner on the beach at Marina di Ravenna, the gardens of Cervia's "Maggio in Fiore", the most fashionable places in Milano Marittima, the feasts of Festa Artusiana

at Forlimpopoli, the Settimana della Micizia of Gatteo Mare, Augustus' Arch and the Tiberius Bridge of Rimini, and the Palio del Daino of Mondaino.

All this happens while Ravenna Festival enhances the value of the art town transforming in into the capital of music, Rimini debates at the Meeting for Friendship Between Peoples and keeps fit at the Fitness Festival, and Ferrara organises races between the riders of the Palio di San Giorgio and a challenge between hot air balloonists.

History is life. The Abbey of San Mercuriale in Forli and the Rocca Malatestiana of Cesena are there to bear witness to the fact that centuries pass but

history survives. And Mosaic by Night, the evening opening of the monuments that Ravenna promotes, is the most fitting publicity vehicle.
