

Without their support, this publication would not have been possible. Background

Trashigang Dzongkhag is bordered by Mongar Dzongkhag in the west, Samdrup Jongkhar and Pemagatshel Dzongkhag in the South, Trashigang Dzongkhag in the north and Indian state of Aranachal Pradesh in the east. Trashigang is one of the largest Dzongkhags in the country with a total land area of 3,066.90 Sq. Km. In 2009; the projected population for the Dzongkhag was 51,781. Dangme chu, which is one of the largest rivers in the country passes through the Dzongkhag. The elevation in the Dzongkhag ranges from 600 to 4500 meters above the mean sea level. The climate is mainly temperate with an annual rainfall between 1000 to 2000 mm.

Trashigang Dzongkhag has three Dungkhags namely; Sakteng, Wamrong and Thrimshing. It has fifteen Gewogs viz; Bartsham, Bidung, Kanglung, Kangpara, Khaling, Lumang, Merak, Phongmey, Radhi, Sakteng, Samkhar, Shongphu, Thrimshig, Uzorong and Yangneer. Majority of the people depend on livestock and subsistence agricultural farming.

The Dzongkhag has 6 Extended Classroom, 35 Community Primary Schools, 12 Primary Schools, 8 Lower Secondary Schools, 5 Middle Secondary Schools, 3 Higher Secondary Schools, 1 National Institute for the Visually Impaired, 1 Institute of Electrical Engineering in Rangjung and 1 tertiary education center (Sherubtse College) which sums up to 72 schools/institutes with total students of 14,379 in 2010. There are 3 hospitals (including IMTART, RBA), 22 Basic Health Unit (both grade I & II), 3 sub posts and 57 Out Reach Clinics rendering public health and 85.5 % of the population has access to safe drinking water supply. Almost all the Gewogs have good road network except for a few Gewogs like Merak, Sakteng and Kangpara which pose considerable problem in delivering developmental services to the people in these Gewogs.

Trashigang Dzong was built in 1659 by Trongsa Penlop, Chogyel Minjur Tempa the 3rd Deb of Bhutan and was named as “Bengkhar”. But it was later renamed as Trashigang, “the Fortress of the Auspicious Mountain”.

The Dzong has 8 different Lhakhangs and these are Lam Lhakhang in the central tower which is dedicated to Shabdrung Rimpoche, the Tshechu Lhakhang with Guru Tshengye, the Goenkhang dedicated to deities Mahakala and Mahakali, the Dupthob Lhakhang for Dupthob Thangthong Gyalpo and other great Buddhist saints, the Kuenray Lhakhang, the Tshokshing Lhakhang which has the lineage of Drukpa, Karmapa, Nyingmapa and Zogchen displayed and the Dema Lhakhang with 21 kinds of Demas.
