## Bag measures approximately 13" wide by 12 " high below the handles.

MODA DEA ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ "Ticker Tape ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ": 4 Balls No. 9815 Tropical.

Crochet Hook: 8mm [US L-11].
Yarn needle; stitch marker; 5.5" x 5.5" Round Rattan Handles DSB083.

GAUGE: 2 ch- $5 \mathrm{Ips}=31 / 2^{\prime \prime} ; 4$ rnds = 3 3/4" in pat. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## NOTE: Use 2 strands held together as one throughout.

FIRST SIDE: Ch 9.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 8 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, skip first sc, dc in each sc to end; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [ch 5, sc in next sc] 7 times; turn - 7 lps.

Rows 5, 6, 7: [Ch 5, sc in lp] 7 times; turn. Fasten off at the end of Row 7 .

SECOND SIDE: Work same as First Side EXCEPT do not fasten off at end of Row 7.

Joining Row: [Ch 5, sc in Ip] 7 times, ch 5 ; with right side of First Side facing, sc in first Ip of First Side, [ch 5, sc in Ip] 6 times, ch 5 , bring other side around making sure that work is not twisted and sc in first Ip of this row - 15 ch- 5 Ips. Place marker on last ch-5 Ip made.

Next Rnds: * Ch 5, sc in next Ip; rep from * around and around without joining until there are a total of 13 rnds completed, end last rnd in Ip above marker.

Next Rnd: [Ch 3, sc in next Ip] 14 times, ch 3; join with a sl st in first sc.

Last Row: Fold last round in half with the last sc at your right; working through both thicknesses sc evenly across the bottom edge. Fasten off.

FINISHING: Fold Rows 1-3 to the wrong side over one of the handles and sew in place. Rep with remaining handle. Weave in ends.
