The Great Divide *Remain* in Stillwater

About ten years ago four guys who met in Stillwater got together to play in a band. They each played in other bands separately and had other things going on with their music. One of the members stood out as a songwriter. After playing together for a year they decided to put some original songs down to make an album.

Five albums, countless concerts and shows and thousands of fans later, the Great Divide is coming home to celebrate a major milestone in their career.

The four-man band will release their fifth album, *Remain*, at the Wormy Dog Concert Hall on Saturday, Nov. 2.

And the four guys don't think the date is at all coincidental. Lead vocalist and guitar player Mike McClure, Rhythm guitarist Scotte Lester, bassist Kelley Green and drummer J.J. Lester feel that OSU's Homecoming weekend serves as just as much of a homecoming for them.

"We started out here in Stillwater and we feel the Wormy Dog is kind of our home, musically. Some of our first gigs were there," said J.J. Lester. "With OSU celebrating Homecoming we feel we are doing the same."

The Great Divide began playing at the Wormy Dog ten years ago when previous owner, Chuck Thompson, was running both the bar and the concert hall. After Thompson sold the establishment to current owner Eric Wooley in 1998, only the bar remained.

Wooley, feeling the pressure of bringing in larger acts that had outgrown the Wormy Dog, reopened the concert hall just in the past month.

"Stillwater needed a venue to present larger acts. The Wormy Dog was just too small for the Pat Greens and Cross Canadian Ragweeds," said Wooley.

The concert hall can hold 550 people and looks forward to hosting

nationally known acts like Robert Earl Keen and Roger Creager in upcoming shows.

Mike McClure wrote or co-wrote all but one of the songs on *Remain*. The album holds ten tracks that introduce fans to a new side of the Great Divide.

The band does not feel the music has changed, just the presentation. "We took four guys playing music and presented that on the CD," said Lester. "We didn't add any instruments that give music a traditional country feel."

This is why some people feel the songs reveal a "rock" side of the Great Divide. Musically, the songs reveal the true talent the Great Divide has to offer.

The lyrics in the song "Moon is Almost Full" and the entire musical compilation of songs like "Gypsy Steel" and "Bummin' Around" are highlights of the whole album. But it is very difficult to single out one song to consider a favorite.

"I think it is the best work we have ever done," said Lester. "We wanted to make an album that we could be really proud of and not try to please anyone but our fans," he continued.

Remain was recorded in three different studios in Nashville with producer Chris Leuzinger and appears on the Great Divide's label, E92 Records.

"Usually, we record albums in two or three weeks. *Remain* took four months," said Lester. "That is how important this album is to us. We gave it everything we had," he added.

Remain was previously available on the Great Divide website as a limited edition. The national release date is Nov. 5. The new release will offer new packaging and availability in major retail outlets like Hastings and Wal-Mart.

The Great Divide will also be having an in-store promotion at Hastings in Stillwater on Nov. 5, but the easiest way to pick up a copy will be the night of the release party.

No Justice will open the show with the Great Divide taking the stage about 11 p.m. No Justice is a local band that has been proving themselves to fans and music followers as the premier up and coming band in Stillwater and has been opening for the Great Divide at numerous shows this fall. For more information on No Justice, check out their website, www.nojustice.com.

Tickets for the show are available online at www.thegreatdivide.com and at Coney Island, the Barn and the Wormy Dog for \$15. Tickets will also be available at the door for the same price.

"I believe we make good records," said Lester. "We set out to make *Remain* a major milestone in our career and I think we accomplished that," he added.

Finally!!!! All-American Rejects Release CD

A few years ago, they were complaining about high school, girls, and how much flack they got for being "kids" in Michael's College Bar. Now, the All-American Rejects have grown up, and they have a new CD to show for it.

The self-titled CD, released by Doghouse Records, has been seeing airplay across the nation already with the single *Swing*, *Swing* scoring nightly points on Z-104.5 The Edge's Top 10 at 10 in Tulsa.

Their touring success has been going well also. After a brief CD release at Hasting's, they were greeted by a sold out warehouse at Curly's in Tulsa. They returned to Stillwater the next evening, a Wednesday night, and played to an ever-increasing, over-capacity crowd at Michael's College Bar. I was one of the sardines squeezed in to see the show, and, hopefully, not the only one in attendance to realize that a phoenix is rising from the ashes of a couple of cocky guys from Oklahoma.

I had seen many of their live performances from the last few years and expected to see a good show. When guitarist Nick Wheeler mentioned that vocalist Tyson Ritter had a sore throat and was home resting, my hopes sank a little. Fortunately, when Tyson arrived, he brought a whole lot of enthusiasm with him, and his voice even made the trip.

This show was one that would have laughed in the face of naysayers from this little burb. Not only were they guys a full band again, adding Mike Kennerty on guitar and Chris Gaylor on the drums, but they lashed out with a full onslaught of pop-punk that would turn heads appreciatively.

Their CD is full of everything that makes the Rejects sound, from Tyson's ever-quirky, but catchy, vocal structures to Nick's quick-fisted guitar riffs and keyboard loops. Now that they've added the new members, their sound is rocking from the start of every show. I do have to admit, when it was just the two of them and some electronic drums, I was a little worried. But these guys have turned around and put out a great record.

With songs like *Swing*, *Swing* already getting some airplay, and other great tunes like *One More Sad Song* and *Drive Away* waiting in the wings, the punks of Stillwater are bound for greatness.

Currently, they are touring with The Beautiful Mistake, and are booked solid throughout November, returning to the Green Door in Oklahoma City, November 26. In The Spotlight... Red Door Studios

It has been said that the red door is a traditional welcome symbol. There have been numerous examples of this throughout history. Dating back to the laws of King Ethelbert in 600 A.D., those fleeing persecution found asylum inside the red doors of the church in England. Many centuries later Florence Nightingale turned herself into Elizabeth Arden and built a beauty empire on that same famous red door.

Stillwater has its own version of a red door, and its history is still evolving.

Nathan Clewell began Red Door Studios in 1997. As the lead singer and guitarist for Another Roadside Attraction, his love and intrigue for the recording process would also allow him to record the band. At that time, however, the production service was called Big Hombre Productions.

"A big part of music is the live interaction a band or act has with the audience," he said. "It is a challenge to reach people through a recording the way you do when you're in the same room."

It was that same intrigue that led him to recording other artists beginning in 1999 after the band broke up.

It was at this time the business received a new name and a new identity. The red door on the front of Nathan and his wife, Cari Hollrah's house, which doubled as the recording studio, was red. This gave Nathan an interesting idea.

"An artist I recorded wanted to give me credit on his album," said Clewell. "I needed a name for my studio and Red Door seemed to fit."

Currently, Red Door Studios offers just about any service an up and coming musical act could ask for. Nathan actually calls his studio a "project studio" rather than limiting it to recording.

Although he has worked with full bands, the studio usually records acoustic or smaller acts using an eight-track digital recorder. Some of

those acts include several local artists such as No Justice, Van & Cage, Remede, Bob Childers, the punk band Ugly Tree and Nathan and Cari themselves.

One artist who used Red Door Studios feels Nathan's ability is beyond his experience. "Nathan did a great job with our CD," said Van Marsalis of Van & Cage. "He turned a little acoustic demo into a great sound for us."

But it doesn't stop there. Red Door Studios also offers graphic design artwork for promotional materials and cd jackets and web page design. Other services include transferring records or tapes to cds and using software to clean up imperfections on records and tapes before transferring them.

As Nathan looks to the future he hopes to upgrade his equipment soon.

"I work at Daddy O's full-time and I am letting my equipment pay for itself. I am planning to upgrade from the eight-track digital to a 24-track soon," said Clewell. "Eventually I will use the software *ProTools* that will allow me to integrate a computer into the recording process," he continued.

Nathan feels the upgrades and innovations will build his studio into a full recording studio that will facilitate every need of even the largest bands.

As for the immediate future, Nathan is working on projects with Bob Childers, No Justice and Jesse Tabish, formerly of the All-American Rejects. He and Cari are also booked to perform around Stillwater including weekly performances at Stillwater Bay and Mike's College Bar.

Red Door Studios might not promise refuge or beauty, but it does welcome artists into Nathan's home and offers professional recording and graphics services that leave any competition behind.

Martians & Slapstick in Town & Gown Show

Typically, bad performances and a production where everything that could possibly go wrong, does, are two things that Stillwater's Town and Gown Theater in the Round directors and casts work hard to avoid.

But, that's just what Director Jeri Seefeldt and the cast of five are working hard to make happen in the comedy "They Came From Mars and Landed Outside the Farndale Avenue Church Hall in Time for the Townswomen's Guild's Coffee Morning" - a spoof on community theater. The show runs November 7-17. The box office opens for ticket sales Monday, November 4.

Each actor will assume several roles in this comedy, which is an intentional bad play within a play. They are: Ginger Thomas, Linda Thrasher, Billy McCollom, Ginny McCollom and Michele Tillman.

"As the Fringe play named this year's winner for the longest title, 'They Came From Mars . . .' is funny. Fringe plays are a bit off-center, edgy - wacky," Seefeldt said. "We think that the audience will be kept in stitches throughout most of the absurdity they'll see on stage, performed by 'The Farndale Dramatic Society' who are very successful in making this play a perfect example of failure."

It's a tactic seen at many a low-budget Fringe comedy over the years.

"I was trying to find a funny show, and came across this play, which is one in a series of very popular plays in England," she said. "There are 10-12 Farndale shows that have been written by David McGillivray and Walter Zerlin Jr. based on the mother of the authors' little theater group."

"These plays spoof well-known productions such as Peter Pan, Scrooge and murder mysteries. Their version of 'MacBeth' recently won best show recently in Edinborough Festival Theater in Scotland," Seefeldt said.

The story "They Came From Mars. . . : is a simple story. It's a typical boy-meets-girl-while-evil-Martians-kidnap-professor's-robot kind of thing, but the plot is largely immaterial to the Monty Python-like antics of the "Farndale Dramatic Society" as they make a complete shambles of it.

Props go missing, actors get stuck in their costumes, cues are flubbed, lines of dialogue get mixed up, sound effects are mismatched, and whole variety of slapstick that has been called "truly brilliant."

"The experienced ensemble cast does a good job of being bad," Seefeldt said. "It makes one wonder what they could do with Shakespeare." The show will run Nov. 7-17 at 7:30 p.m. Thurs. - Sat. and 2:30 Sunday. For information on Town and Gown tickets, shows, or volunteer opportunities, call 405-372- 9122 or visit the Website at:

There is a definite change in store for the OSU Allied Arts performance series on Thursday, November 14 when the Gould Piano Trio comes to Stillwater and the OSU campus to perform in the Seretean Center Concert Hall at 8:00 p.m. After jazz and pop concerts by the Alison Brown Quartet and Leon Russell, the Gould Piano Trio offers a world-class performance of classical chamber music.

Formed in 1987, the trio has established a reputation as one of the most exciting ensembles to emerge on the world stage in recent years. Highly regarded in the field of chamber music, they constantly perform in major venues both in the UK and overseas. They have recently performed in New York's Carnegie Hall, the Amsterdam Concertgebouw, the Brussels Palais des Beaux-Arts, and major halls in London, Paris, Cologne, Athens, Vienna, Edinburgh, and Spoleto (Italy). International tours have taken the trio to South Korea, Taiwan, Argentina, Brazil, Australia, and most of Europe. They regularly perform live broadcasts on BBC Radio 3.

The Gould Piano Trio has been the recipient of many international awards: First Prize at the Charles Hennen Competition in Holland, First Prize in the Melbourne International Chamber Music Competition in

Australia, First Prize and Audience Prize at the Premio Vittorio Gui Competition in Florence, Italy, and several British awards.

Lucy Gould, violin, Benjamin Frith, piano, and Alice Neary, cello, are all outstanding internationally-known musicians and soloists in their own right. Together, they present a superlative demonstration of great artistry, commanding sense of style, superb refinement of tonal balance and blend, and power of communication. It is truly a unique opportunity to experience an ensemble of this ability and international stature in a local venue.

The Inside Story lecture for this performance will be given by Professor Larry Stomberg, who is instructor of cello (and bass) in the OSU Music Department and Co-Principal cellist with the Oklahoma City Philharmonic. As usual, the Inside Story will be held in the Seretean Center Room 123 at 7:00 p.m. on the night of the performance. And as always, the Inside Story is free and open to the public.
