WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:



POWER DEFENSE: Last year, Dario Franchitti overcame what some people thought was an insurmountable advantage held by Will Power over the final third of the season. In 2011, Power (2010 Indy® Grand Prix of Sonoma PEAK Performance Pole Award and race winner) looks to turn the tables on Franchitti (above) who did not finish his first IZOD IndyCar® Series race in 42 races two weeks ago in Loudon, New Hampshire. Can the Australian, who enters Sonoma trailing Franchitti by 47 points, eat into the Scotsman's point lead?

DIXON'S MOMENTUM: Coming off his fourth podium in five races, Scott Dixon looks to ride his recent success back into the title picture. Can Dixon, who won at Sonoma in 2007 and finished second last season, get a second win at Infineon Raceway and make the championship a threeman race?



ALL IN THE FAMILY: The Andretti name has been a major part of open-wheel racing history and the latest generation of the famed family hopes to recapture his success in Sonoma. Marco Andretti, whose grandfather Mario finished second in the first Indy car race at the track, returns to the site his first IZOD IndyCar Series win. Can Marco, who also won at the track in Firestone Indy Lights, regain his winning form on the Infineon circuit and help his father Michael score his third win at the track as an owner and fourth 2011 win (MoveThatBlock.com Indy 225 race winner, Ryan Hunter-Reay, above)?

THE COMPETITION: The Indy Grand Prix of Sonoma has featured six different winners since the series' first visit to Sonoma: Tony Kanaan, 2005; Marco Andretti, 2006; Scott Dixon, 2007; Helio Castroneves, 2008; Dario Franchitti, 2009; and Will Power, 2010. Can one of these drivers become the first repeat winner at Infineon Raceway or will another new face find their way to Wine Country Winner's Circle?

HOMETOWN HERO: Sausalito native JR Hildebrand has controlled the race for Sunoco Rookie of the Year since the beginning of the season, but James Hinchcliffe's recent success has tightened up the race. Hildebrand, a former winner at Sonoma in Firestone Indy Lights, leads Hinchcliffe by 17 points heading into the final road course of the season. Can Hildebrand, who began his racing career racing go-karts at Infineon Raceway, strengthen his case for Rookie of the Year at his home race?
