

## Cate Hat

Rowan

### Materials

#### YARN

Rowan baby Alpaca DK  
A Thistle 202  
2 x 50gm

#### NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

**BEADS** - approx 450 beads

#### TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4mm (US 8) needles.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sL2togK = slip next 2 sts as though to K2tog; p2sso = pass 2 slipped sts over; bead loop = make bead loop by taking yarn to back (RS) of work and slipping 5 beads up next to st just worked, slip next st purlwise from left needle to right needle and return yarn back to front (WS) of work, leaving beads forming a loop in front of slipped st on RS.

Beading note: Before starting to knit, thread beads onto yarn. To do this, thread a fine sewing needle (one that will easily pass through the beads) with sewing thread. Knot ends of thread and then pass end of yarn through this loop. Thread a bead onto sewing thread and then gently slide it along and onto knitting yarn. Continue in this way until required number of beads are on yarn.

### Instructions

#### HAT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 107 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: P2, \*bead loop, P2, rep from \* to end.

Rows 3 to 5: Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: K5, \*yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K6, rep from \* to last 6 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K4.

Row 8: As row 6.

Row 9: K3, \*K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K3, rep from \* to end.

Row 10: As row 6.

Row 11: K2, \*K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

Row 12: As row 6.

Row 13: K4, \*yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K5, rep from \* to last 7 sts, yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K4.

Row 14: P5, bead loop, \*P7, bead loop, rep from \* to last 5 sts, P5.

Row 15: K1, \*yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K6, rep from

\* to last 10 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K5, K2tog, yfwd, K1.

Row 16: As row 6.



R O W A N

Row 17: K2, \*yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

Row 18: As row 6.

Row 19: K3, \*yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from \* to end.

Row 20: As row 6.

Row 21: K1, K2tog, yfwd, K5, \*yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K5, rep from \* to last 3 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1.

Row 22: P9, bead loop, \*P7, bead loop, rep from \* to last 9 sts, P9.

Rep rows 7 to 22 once more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape crown

Row 1 (RS): (K5, K2tog) 15 times, K2. 92 sts.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 5: (K4, K2tog) 15 times, K2. 77 sts.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 9: (K3, K2tog) 15 times, K2. 62 sts.

Row 11: Knit.

Row 13: (K2, K2tog) 15 times, K2. 47 sts.

Row 15: Knit.

Row 17: (K1, K2tog) 15 times, K2. 32 sts.

Row 19: Knit.

Row 20: (P2tog) 16 times.

Break yarn and thread through rem 16 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely.

## Cate Scarf

Rowan

### Materials

#### YARN

Rowan baby Alpaca DK

A Thistle 202

3 x 50gm

#### NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

**BEADS** - approx 630 beads

#### TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4mm (US 8) needles.

#### FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf measures 10 cm (4 in) wide and 190 cm (75 in) long.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sL2togK = slip next 2 sts as though to K2tog; p2sso = pass 2 slipped sts over; bead loop = make bead loop by taking yarn to back (RS) of work and slipping 5 beads up next to st just worked, slip next st purlwise from left needle to right needle and return yarn back to front (WS) of work, leaving beads forming a loop in front of slipped st on RS.

### Instructions

#### SCARF

##### First section

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 23 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: P2, (bead loop, P2) 7 times.

Rows 3 to 5: Knit.

Row 6: K2, P19, K2.

Row 7: K7, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K6) twice.

Row 8: As row 6.

Row 9: K5, (K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K3) twice, K2.

Row 10: As row 6.

Row 11: K4, (K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1) twice, K3.

Row 12: As row 6.

Row 13: K6, (yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K5) twice, K1.

Row 14: K2, P5, bead loop, P7, bead loop, P5, K2.

Row 15: K11, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K10.

Row 16: As row 6.

Row 17: K9, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K9.

Row 18: As row 6.

Row 19: K8, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K8.

Row 20: As row 6.

Row 21: K10, yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K10.

Row 22: K2, P9, bead loop, P9, K2.



R O W A N

Rows 7 to 22 form patt.

Cont in patt until first section meas approx 95 cm, ending after patt row 14 and with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): Knit.\*\*

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Second section

Work as given for first section to \*\*.

Join sections

Holding RS of first section against RS of second section, cast off both sets of sts at same time, taking one st from one section with corresponding st of other section.
