














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Nestled in the heart of Virginia's famed Shenandoah Valley, historic Staunton is a revitalization success story. Its dynamic downtown features a special blend of small-town hospitality and big-city amenities. The city boasts nationally recognized performing arts venues, historic attractions and a lively grassroots music scene. Hundreds of restored Victorian-era buildings house an eclectic mix of independently owned shops and restaurants.

The National Trust for Historic Preservation touts Staunton's "dynamic downtown, cultural diversity, attractive architecture, and strong commitment to historic preservation and revitalization." The walkable city boasts six historic districts. Staunton is ideally located for quick and easy excursions to nearby areas that showcase the best of Virginia's natural resources and attractions, such as the Blue Ridge Parkway, Natural Bridge, and Civil War battlefields.

Staunton is one of the oldest cities west of the Blue Ridge Mountains. In 1732, Scots-Irish settler John Lewis and his family became the first Europeans to settle in the area, and a Courthouse for Augusta County was built here in 1745. Lots and streets were laid out in 1747 for the town of Staunton (pronounced STAN-ton), named after Lady Rebecca Staunton, the wife of Colonial Governor William Gooch. Strategically located at the intersection of the Great Wagon Road and early roads to the west, Staunton developed as a major center for trade. This was greatly enhanced with the arrival in 1854 of the Virginia Central Railroad. This railroad would later play a key role during the Civil War when the Shenandoah Valley served as the "Breadbasket of the Confederacy." Because Staunton remained largely unscathed during the Civil War, it retains one of Virginia's finest collections of authentic 19th century architecture.





Civil War Era in Staunton

Staunton played a pivotal role during the Civil War years when the Shenandoah Valley served as the "Breadbasket of the Confederacy." While most of the battles were being fought north or west of the town, it was the presence of the Virginia Central Railroad that provided a vital link between the Valley and eastern Virginia, making Staunton an important supply depot for the Confederacy. Staunton has one architectural advantage over most of other small towns in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia: it escaped the Civil War unscathed. Many of its 18th and early 19th century homes and buildings still stand and are wonderfully preserved.

outdoor adventures



There are many opportunities for outdoor recreation in and around Staunton. From birding and wildlife watching, to hiking and camping, or picnicking and swimming, you will find plenty of chances to re-connect with nature. Maybe you'll try bicycling through Gypsy Hill Park or experience a geocaching adventure. All you need is a mobile GPS, and a group of fun-loving people. Below you will find a few of our local's favorite outdoor recreational activities.

Betsy Bell Wilderness Park

Betsy Bell Road, Staunton, VA 24401

This park offers a magnificent view of the Shenandoah Valley from its observation platform (elev. 1,959 feet), which looks due east toward the Blue Ridge Mountains. The summit has picnic facilities and an observation area. The park may be reached by turning onto Betsy Bell Road from Greenville Avenue (Route 11). Mountain bikers may wish to test their endurance by tackling the entire length of the access road. It offers a difficult climb, a breathtaking view, and an exciting downhill run. Hikers will find a welcome natural area to explore and may catch a glimpse of the deer herd which haunts the slopes.

Blue Ridge Parkway

Outstanding scenery and recreational opportunities make the Blue Ridge Parkway one of the most popular components of the National Park System. "America's Favorite Drive" winds its way 469 miles through mountain meadows and past seemingly endless vistas. Split-rail fences, old farmsteads and historic structures complement spectacular views of distant mountains and neighboring valleys. www.blueridgeparkway.org

Crabtree Falls

11581 Crabtree Falls Hwy. (Rt. 56), Montebello, VA 24464 www.fs.fed.us

The Crabtree Falls Trail features a series of five cascades and a number of smaller ones that fall a total distance of 1,200 feet. The trail provides views of the falls from overlooks constructed to accent the beauty of the valley. The first overlook is just 700 feet from the lower parking lot, making it an excellent stopover for travelers. The more adventuresome hiker may continue to Crabtree Meadows where the trail ends, or to the Appalachian Trail, which is just one half mile beyond Crabtree Meadows.

George Washington and Jefferson National Forest

These two national forests stretch from one end of Virginia to the other, as well as extending into West Virginia, along the ruggedly beautiful Appalachians. Virtually every type of outdoor recreation activity you can imagine is available. Of course hiking, fishing, mountain bicycling and camping lead the way, but don't forget hawk watching, cross-country skiing, horseback riding, nature photography, and orienteering.www.fs.fed.us

Gypsy Hill Park

A sprawling 214 acre park that includes a public golf course, football and baseball stadiums, a gymnasium, a lake, two playgrounds, three youth baseball fields, a public swimming pool, a volleyball court, horseshoe pits, tennis courts, the Gypsy Express Mini Train, the Duck Pond and a bandstand. Pavilions with modest outdoor cooking facilities and picnic tables are spread throughout the park. 1.3 mile circular roadway is a designated play street and is suitable for walkers, bicyclists and rollerblades. Ramsey's Draft Wilderness is a rugged and steep piece of land on the eastern side of Shenandoah Mountain, a region redolent with memories of America's Civil War. One of the largest tracts of virgin forest left in the eastern United States has been preserved here. Among the variety of plants you may see are some virgin hardwoods and hemlocks standing in the upper elevations and a more typical Appalachian forest of tulip poplar, red oak, and basswood. Watch for deer and the many smaller mammals that inhabit the woods of Virginia.


The U.S. Congress designated the Saint Mary's Wilderness in 1984 and it now has a total of 9,835 acres. The largest Virginia Wilderness on national forest land, it is located in the Blue Ridge Mountain Range. It has elevations ranging from 1,700 feet to 3,400 feet, and includes 17 miles of trails. Along the Saint Mary's you can fish for native trout, walk through rhododendron and mountain laurel, and discover a lovely waterfall. The area was mined for iron ore and manganese until the mid-1900s, and evidence of those bygone days remains along the Saint Mary's River Gorge.


