Description


The ECH is a protective helmet consisting of a ballistic protective shell, pad suspension system, and 4-point chinstrap/napestrap retention system. The ECH is compatible with, and is typically worn in conjunction with other components of infantry combat equipment such as Body Armor Systems, protective spectacles/goggles and/or prescription glasses, night vision equipment and a camouflage fabric helmet cover. The ECH is of one Type (tactical cut) and two Classes, which are differentiated by their retention systems: Class I uses the X-Back for the USMC & Navy and Class II uses the H-Back for the Army.
