GUEST SERVICES

Enhanced security measures remain in effect at West Point and at all stadium access points for all home football games. Please be aware that fans attending games this fall will encounter various security checks before entering Michie Stadium. Anyone entering the stadium is subject to be searched. We strongly urge all fans to arrive to the stadium as early as possible to avoid delays.

GAME DAY CENTRAL: Visit www.goARMYsports.com for all your Game Day information.

GUEST SERVICE BOOTHS: Are located at Gates 1, 3, 5 and 7.

LOST & FOUND: Lost and found items can be claimed at the Guest Service Booths or by calling the Army Athletic Association at (845) 938-4108.

FIRST AID: The First Aid Station is located under Section 25. In case of emergency, please notify the nearest usher or the Military Police.

GAME PROGRAMS: Are available at most entrance gates.

ATMS: Two are located near concession stand 1 in the east stands and near concession stand 12 in the west stands.

MERCHANDISE: Two merchandise stores are available on the visitor's side at each end zone. Shirts, hats, sweatshirts, seat cushions, buttons and much more is available.

RESTROOMS: Are located throughout Michie Stadium concourses.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: The following items are prohibited from being brought into Michie Stadium: bottles, cans or beverage containers of any kind (to include water), food, bags/backpacks larger than 12"x12"x12", alcoholic beverages, umbrellas, artificial noisemakers, laser pointers, footballs or throwing objects, signs or flags on sticks or poles, animals (except service animals to aid guests with disabilities), smoking (except in designated areas) and firearms, knives or weapons of any kind. The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is also prohibited inside Michie Stadium. Profanity, soliciting and trespassing are also prohibited.

SMOKING POLICY: Smoking is not permitted in our sports facilities or the seating areas/restrooms of Michie Stadium. Please see the nearest guest service member for the smoking locations nearest to your seating area.

CONCESSIONS: Concession stands are located throughout Michie Stadium. Special delivery requests, box lunches for groups and tailgate catering can be accommodated by phoning (845) 938-7732.

PUBLIC ADDRESS: Messages for the public address announcer are accepted only for medical emergencies and must be approved by an Army athletic official.

HANDICAPPED SERVICES: Handicapped parking accommodations are located in H Lot. A handicapped license plate, state registration or handicapped parking pass is required to gain entrance to the area.



GETTING TO WEST POINT

FROM JFK AIRPORT

VanWyck Parkway to Bronx-Whitestone Bridge. After crossing the bridge, look for the Cross Bronx Expressway. Follow the Cross Bronx Expressway to the Bronx River Parkway north. Take the Bronx River Parkway to left fork for the Sprain Brook Parkway. Follow Sprain Brook Parkway to Route 287, left exit to Tappan Zee Bridge and Interstate 87 (New York State Thruway). Over bridge, take exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). Follow signs for Route 9W north (3d exit off traffic circle). Take the first "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

FROM LA GUARDIA AIRPORT

Take the Whitestone Parkway to Bronx-Whitestone Bridge. After crossing the bridge, look for the Cross Bronx Expressway. Follow the Cross Bronx Expressway to the Bronx River Parkway north. Take the Bronx River Parkway to left fork for the Sprain Brook Parkway. Follow Sprain Brook Parkway to Route 287, left exit to Tappan Zee Bridge and Interstate 87 (New York State Thruway). Over bridge, take exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). FROM NEWARK AIRPORT

Take Interstate 78 West to the Garden State Parkway. Take the GSP north to the end and follow signs for the New York State Thruway (I-87) south. Exit Thruway at exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). Follow signs for Route 9W north (3d exit off traffic circle). Take the first "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

FROM STEWART AIRPORT

Exit airport, make left turn onto New York State Route 207 to the New York State Route 300 interchange. Make left turn onto Route 300, cross New York State Route 17K to the Interstate 84 interchange. Take I-84 east to exit 10 (Route 9W). Make right turn onto 9W south. Take the second "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

PARKING/SHUTTLE BUSES

To better facilitate parking, Army charges \$15 per parking pass for cars in advance and \$20 on game day, while recreational vehicles are \$75 in advance and \$100 on game day. Season passes for RVs may be purchased for \$250. ALL vehicles are required to have a parking pass.

Parking passes are included with a \$125 donation to the Army "A" Club. Season ticket holders who do not donate to the "A" Club may purchase season parking passes for \$50. Non-season ticket holders may purchase a parking pass in advance.

Specific color passes will make it easier for fans to enter through the proper gates — Green Passes: Thayer; Red Passes: Stony Lonesome; Blue Passes: Washington.

Fans with orange-colored general admission parking passes should enter through Washington Gate and will be directed accordingly.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

Free shuttle bus service is provided from the West Point parking lots to the parade ground and Michie Stadium. Each lot is color-coded corresponding to each color-coded bus route. Postgame shuttle bus departure points are:

- Red Kimsey Center
- Blue Stony Lonesome Rd. near Gate 3
- Green Herbert Hall (intersection of Mills Road and Howze Place)
- Handicapped—Gates 1 and 6 at Michie Stadium
- Wheelchair—Gate 6 at Michie Stadium
