On landing at Sittwe, the aircraft ran off the end of the runway coming to rest on soft ground. Three people, among them one of the pilots were injured. The aircraft suffered severe damage to its wings - most severely to its right wing - and foreward fuselage when it hit trees before it came to rest minus its landing gear. Due to stress to the airframe, a number of exits won't open resulting in many passengers getting stuck before all escaped via the emergency doors. The only runway at Sittwe (11 /29) is 1.829 meters in length. According to an analysis by US Defense NOTAM Service, the usable runway length at Sittwe is only 1.340 meters, also, parts of the runway lighting is considered unserviceable.
