
Pinchbeck and Surfleet Ward Profile





Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward is one of 18 wards within South Holland. The ward lies to the north of Spalding. Within this ward are some of the Districts museums: the Pinchbeck Engine Museum and the Bulb Museum. The River Glen runs through this ward.

Key Facts and Figures

Population

The resident population of the ward is **6,419 (5,153 in Pinchbeck and 1,266 in Surfleet)**. The age breakdown of its residents is shown below.

The average age of Pinchbeck's population is **43.3 years**, for Surfleet the average age is **42.8 years** (compared to 42.8 in South Holland and 38.6 in England and Wales).

Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD)

Most recent deprivation statistics¹ are based on areas which are smaller than wards – known as Super Output Areas (SOA). Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward contains 4 SOA's.

There are 32,482 SOAs in England. The SOA with a rank of 1 is the most deprived and 32,482 is the least deprived.

The 4 areas within Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward are ranked at **14,061** (Pinchbeck West and rural), **15,637** (Surfleet), **21,276** (Pinchbeck) and **24,620** (Pinchbeck East). None of these rankings fall on the most deprived end of the scale nationally or specifically within South Holland. Infact Pinchbeck East area is one of the least deprived areas within South Holland.

Economic Activity

The 2001 Census showed that **65.1%** of residents in Pinchbeck aged 16-74 were employed and 1.7% were unemployed. In Surfleet **59.1%** of residents aged 16-74 were employed and 1.9% were unemployed.

More recent unemployment estimates show that in June 2007 unemployment in Pinchbeck was **2.1%** and unemployment in Surfleet was **2.0%** (compared to 1.1% and 1.7% respectively in June 2005). These figures are based on old ward boundaries so the Surfleet figures are based on a wider area than the current 2007 ward boundary. The unemployment rate for South Holland was 2.0% in June 2007. There are no secondary schools in Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward. Young people living in this ward tend to go to Spalding Gleed Boys or Gleed Girls or the Spalding grammar schools if they pass the 11+ exam.

¹ The IMD 2007 combines various elements (income; employment; health and disability; education, skills and training; barriers to housing and services; living environment; crime) to give an overall score of deprivation for each Super Output Area (SOA) in England.

When looking at GCSE achievement of those who live in the ward, 57.8% of pupils living in Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward achieved 5+ GCSE's at grade A-C (compared to 58.3% within South Holland). (Source: Lincolnshire Education Authority).

0% of Key Stage 4 (GCSE) pupils living in Pinchbeck and Surfleet ward are eligible for a free school meal (compared to 4% within South Holland). (Source: Lincolnshire Education Authority).

Overall Pinchbeck is not very well provided for with only 47% of the recommended provision. When broken down into the two types of open space, youth and adult provision is not too bad at 57-64% of the recommended provision. However children's open space provision is poor with only 15-21% of the recommended provision.
