Xerox announces availability of DocuShare 6.5 content management platform

Uxbridge, August 20th, 2009 – Xerox today announced an upgraded version of its existing DocuShare content management platform. Available for the entire product range – DocuShare, DocuShare CPX and DocuShare Express – version 6.5 can store more than 50 million documents, perform search queries within seconds and support sustained intake of over one million imaged documents per day.

"The volume and costs associated with documents are forcing businesses to reassess their enterprise content management needs," said Peter Romaine, Director and General Manager, Xerox Global Services, Xerox UK. "The new capacities in DocuShare version 6.5 make paper-driven work processes and their associated costs obsolete. Once content is digital it can be shared easily and securely between users – opening the door to a more productive workplace."

New DocuShare version 6.5 features include:

- Ability to store more than 50 million documents, performing complex search queries in under three seconds and supporting sustained intake of 12 imaged documents per second, or over one million documents per day
- Autonomy's IDOL search server provides enhanced search engine scalability and performance to DocuShare; requires no re-indexing after adding customer metadata
- VMWare support enables DocuShare to run in VMWare ESX environments for greater deployment flexibility; for example, a customer can implement a virtualised server environment to run multiple DocuShare servers on one physical server box
- EIP Connector allows users to access DocuShare document management features
 from the touch screen of an EIP-enabled Xerox multifunction device; documents can
 be added, browsed, retrieved and printed at the device; users can initiate a document
 workflow by triggering a predefined process when a document is scanned and added
 to a collection
- User and group quotas allows IT administrators to control the amount of data that a user or a group can store in DocuShare, helping conserve IT resources
- Permission levels have been extended from 3 to 6, giving more granular control over content access, and therefore over sensitive or regulated content

DocuShare version 6.5 features will be available immediately in English, French, German and Spanish through Xerox Global Services and DocuShare resellers. Customers on a maintenance contract will receive an upgrade to 6.5 features free of charge.
